This is a challenging time for all of us. We are all facing stress and feeling worried.

Remember that during this period, you remain a trusted and important member of the World Vision team. This means we must all continue to live out our values to not cause harm to others.

Some staff, volunteers or contractors might try to use this period of uncertainty to take advantage of children or vulnerable people, abusing them, harming them, or trading sex for food, vouchers, or money.

This is unacceptable.

If you are aware of anyone affiliated with World Vision who may be causing harm to a child or an adult beneficiary,
