The following updates were provided:		
FAO has been carrying out AAP in the field combined with PSEA. People have been using the hotline but not as many have been using email to communicate.		
Child Protection discussed the importance of ensuring AAP implementation is appropriate for children and those with disabilities as they have different needs and abilities and can't always provide their own feedback. In particular, children without families to advocate on their behalf need to be carefully considered and included in AAP processes.		
World Vision have been applying AAP in the field but consistent access issues have made this difficult. They previously used billboards and volunteers but these are now not as possible because of the strong preference for low profile activities in the face of security concerns. World Vision are currently using a pamphlet to share information and wanted to hear from other colleagues to see how they have been managing the complicated situation, especially if anyone had any innovative suggestions or solutions.		
UNICEF have been using AAP indicators since 2021. They encouraged partners to develop feedback mechanisms and have requested a monthly report on AAP indicators. UNICEF has an interactive AAP dashboard for Myanmar that was launched recently.		
Trocaire do not implement any activities themselves but carry out humanitarian work through partners. They are experiencing increasing challenges in the AAP space due to access and mobility issues. Their partners are concerned about distributing contact details.
