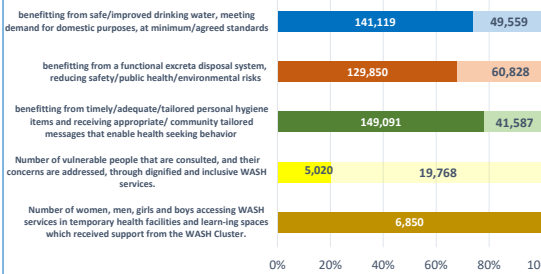
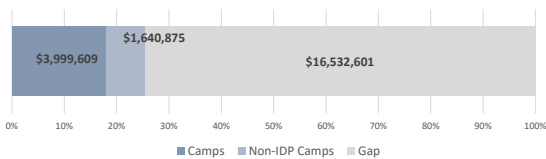


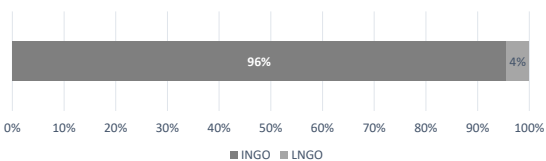
Number of ppl Covered against 2021 HRP targets (IDPs- protracted+new displacement)



Cumulative Funding Received/Gap as of 2021-Q2(US\$)

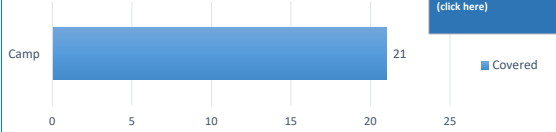

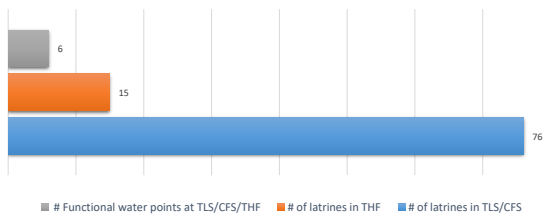

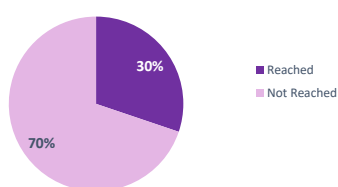

HRPS: Number of women, men, girls and boys accessing WASH services in temporary health facilities and learn-ing spaces which received support from the WASH Cluster

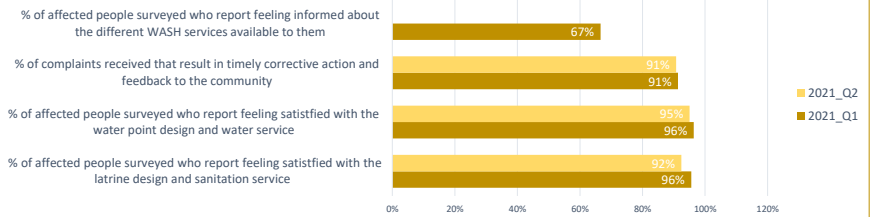

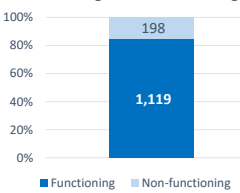

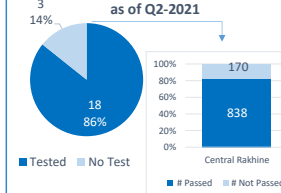


WATER Quantity

of improved water points functioning and non-functioning

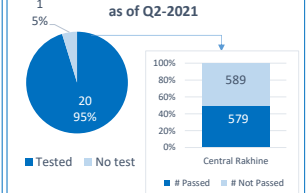


% of Sites which made water quality test at water sources as of Q2-2021

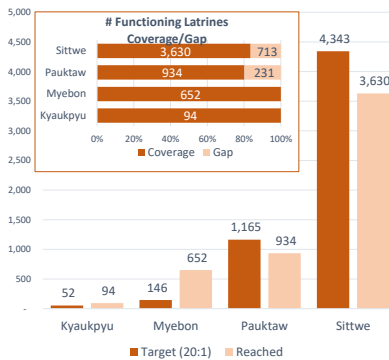
% of Sites which made water quality test at household as of Q2-2021



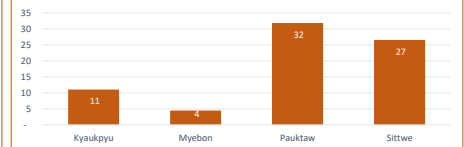

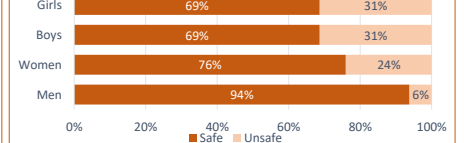
Latrine Target and Reached



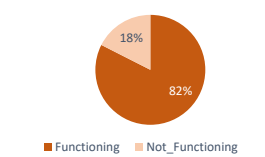
Average functioning adult latrine usage (#PPL:1Latrine)



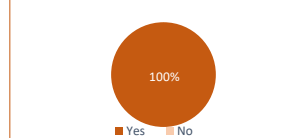

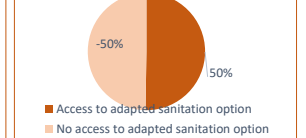

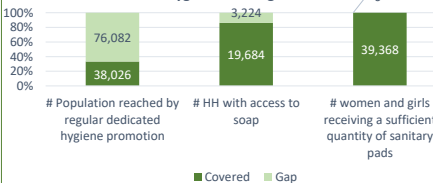
