Description:

Torrential rain in South-East of Myanmar in early August 2019 has caused a severe flooding and many landslides in Mon, Karen states and Tanintharyi region. A major landslide has occurred at the hillside of Thae Phyu Kone village in Paung township on 9th August 2019. It has caused a massive debris flow and has washed down buildings, including a row of standing vehicles with passengers on the road.
