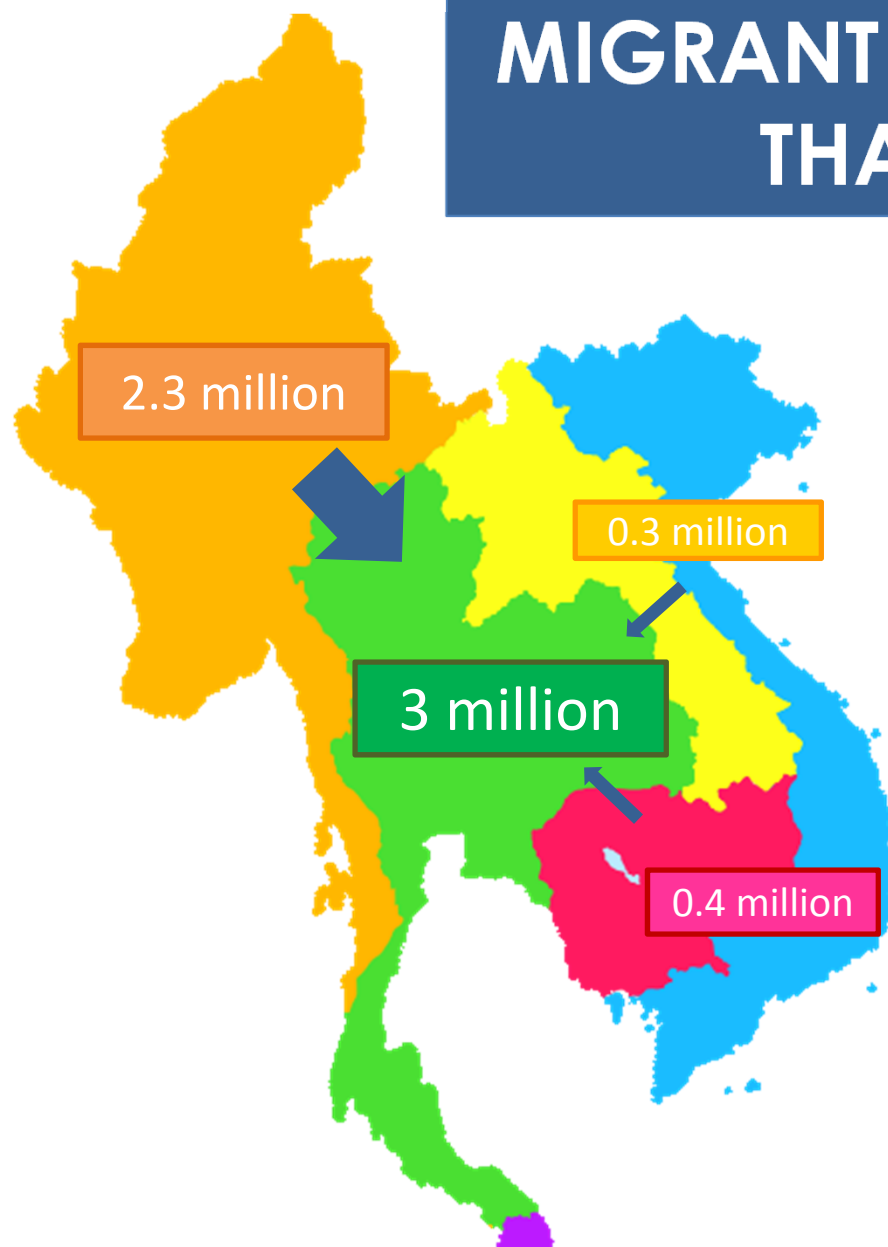

5.36 million jobs need to be filled



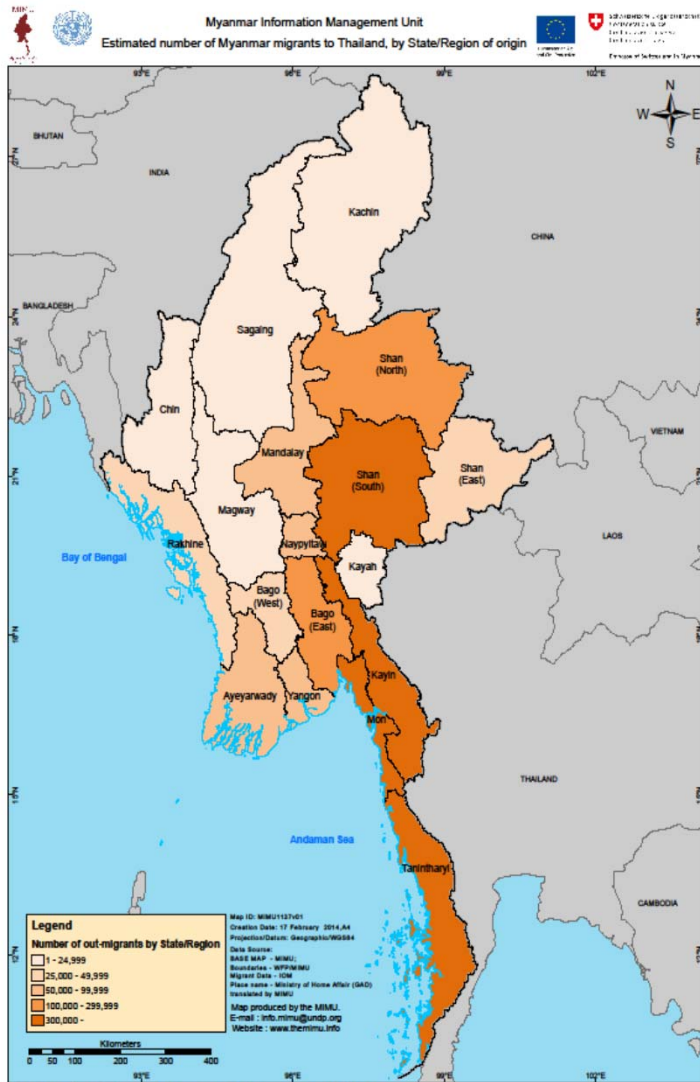
Limitations of the data

Migration Hot-spots

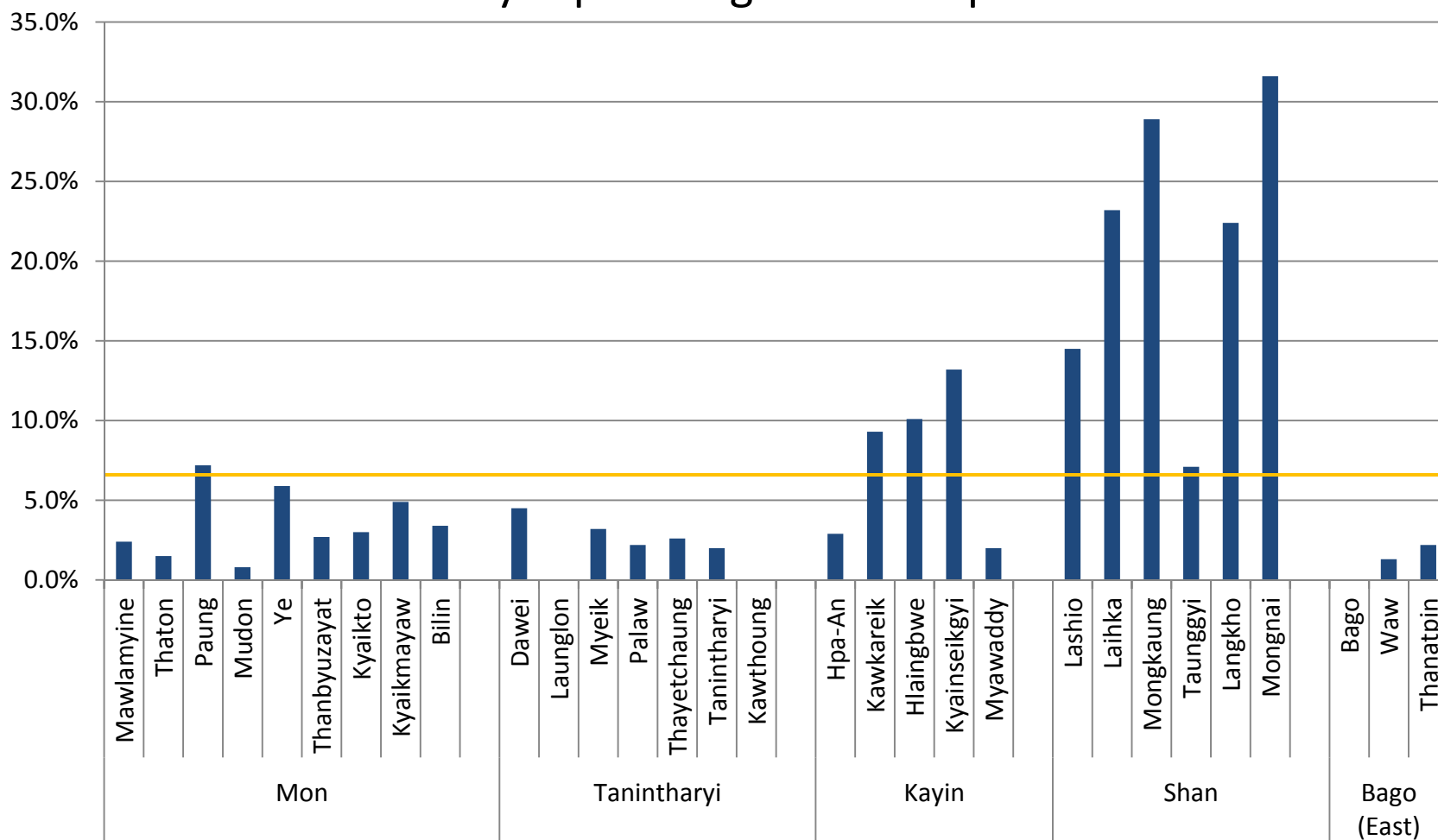
- **76.4%** of surveyed migrants came from **4 states/regions** bordering Thailand
- **68.7%** came from **30 townships** out of 247 townships
- Out-migration rate: **3.8% nationally**, but up to **36% in some areas**

Origin states/regions of surveyed migrants and estimated numbers of migrants

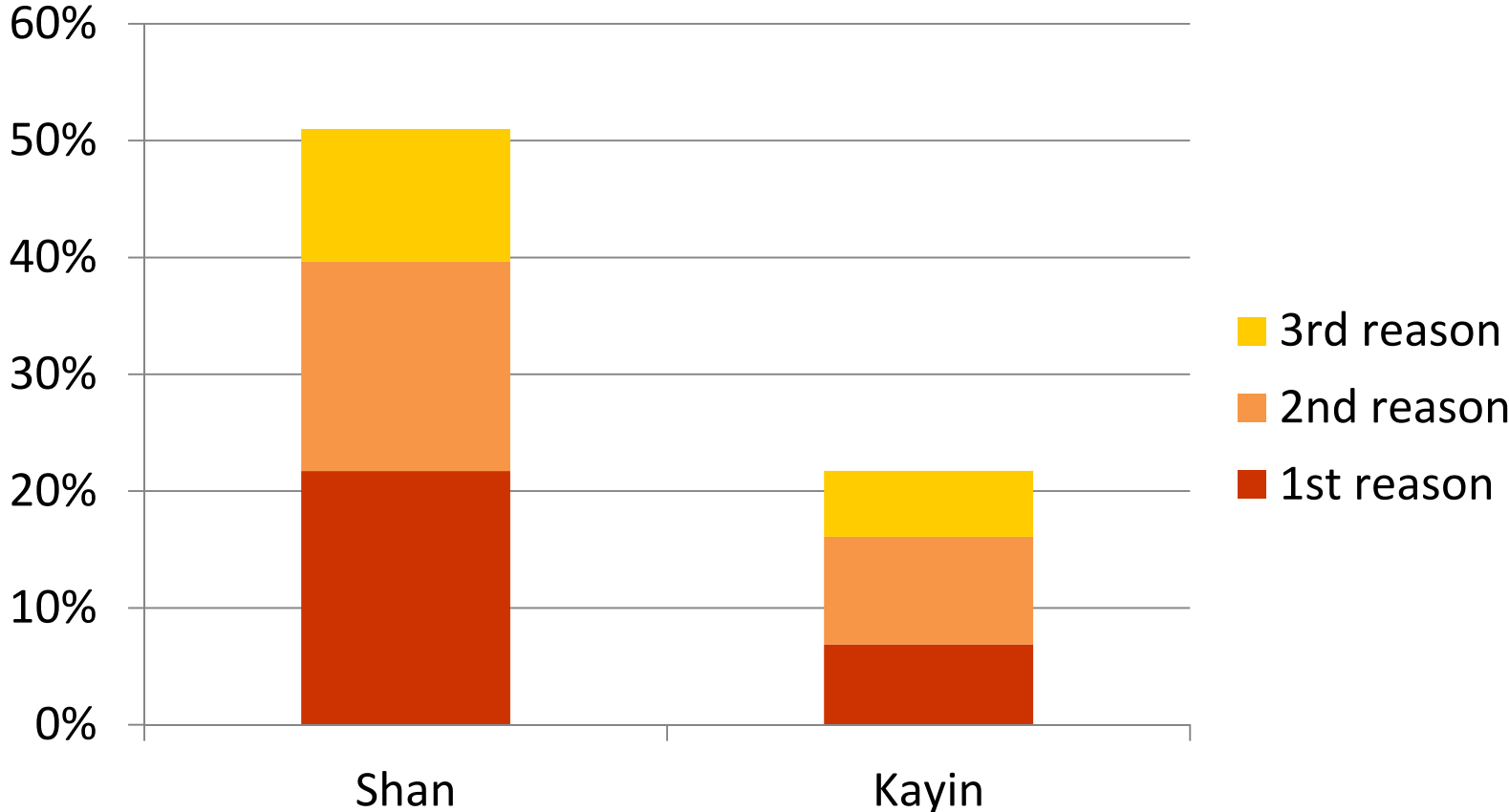

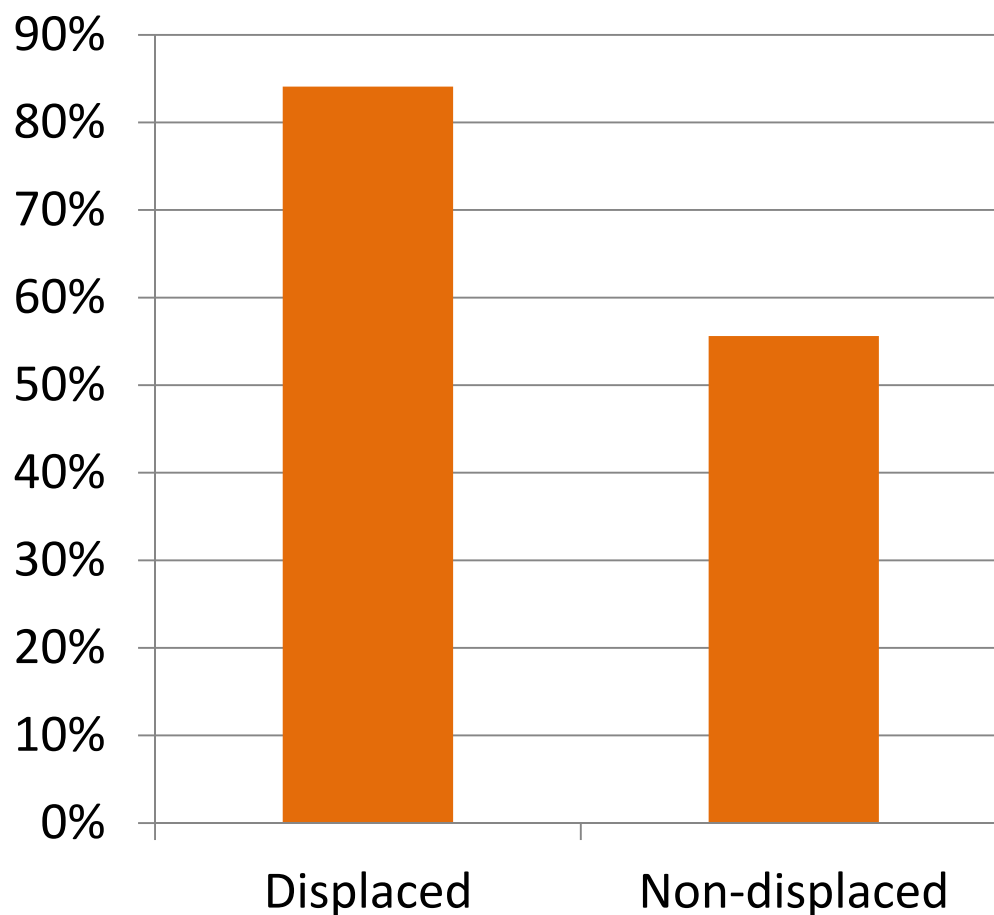
Percentage of migrants with displacement background by top 30 origin townships



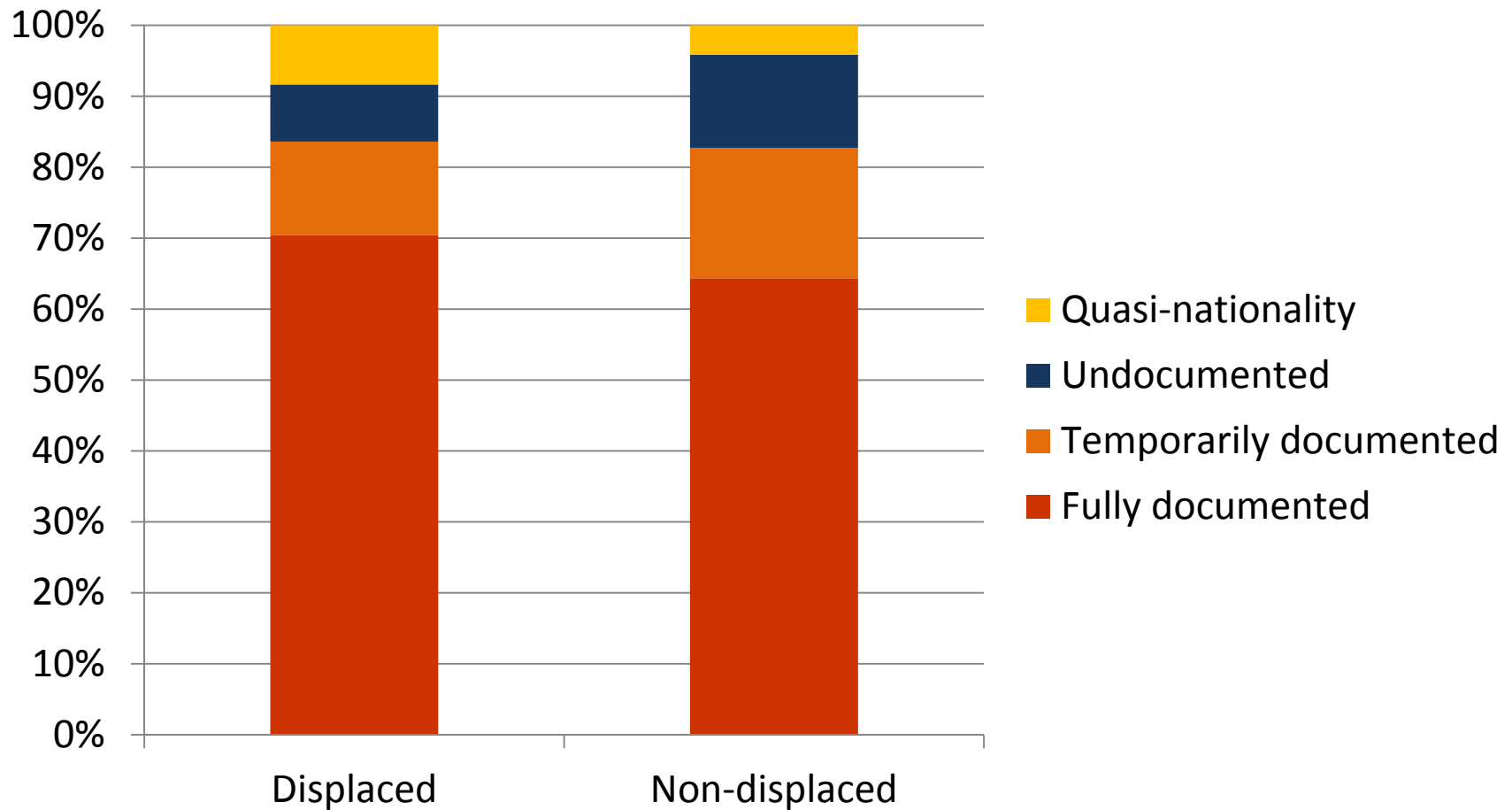
Percentage of Shan and Kayin migrants who cited insecurity and lack of safety as reasons to migrate to Thailand



Percentage of migrants with children whose children are living in Thailand by displacement background

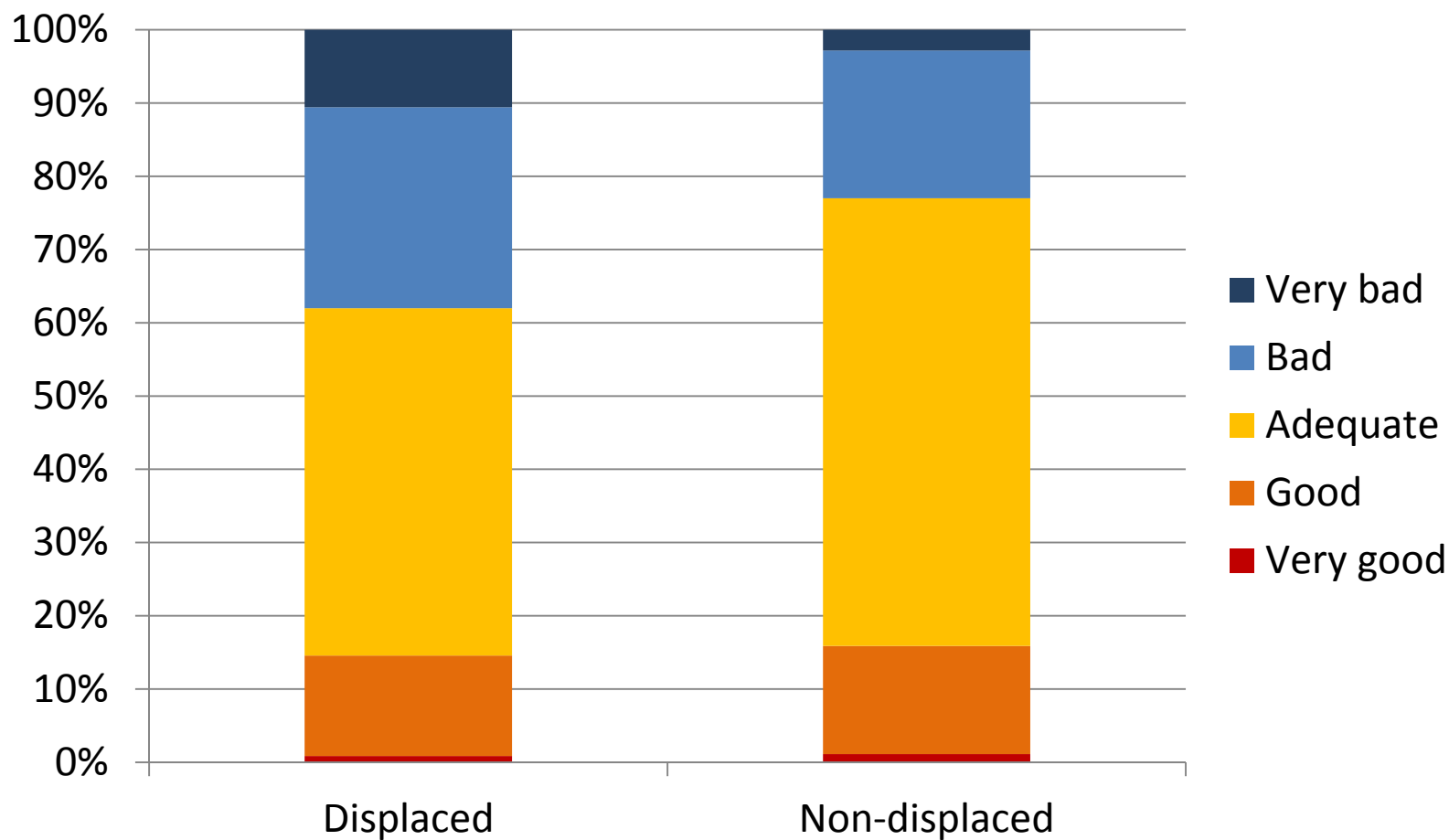


Documentation statuses of migrants by displacement background

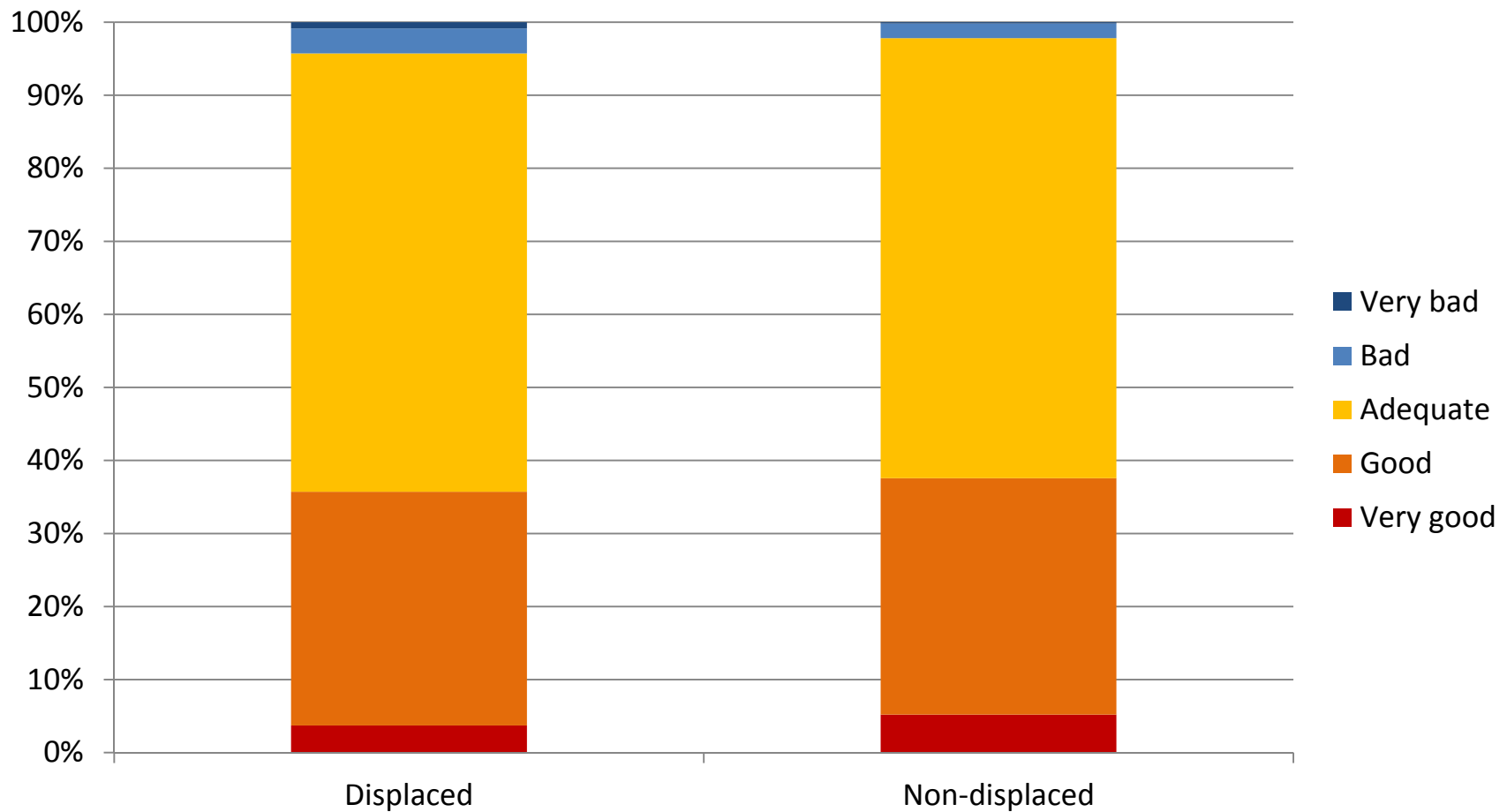


Living conditions of migrants in Myanmar prior to migration

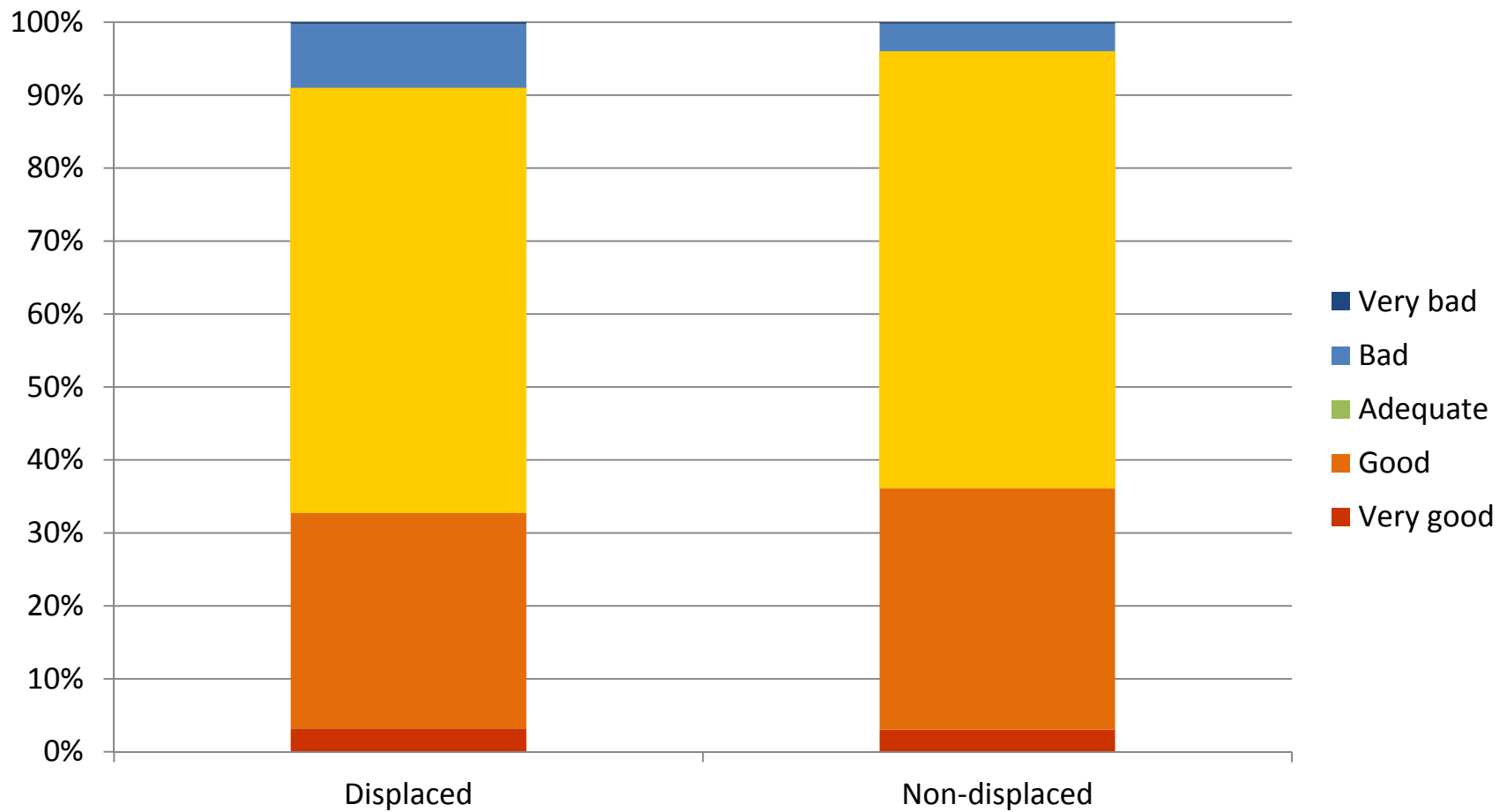

Working conditions of migrants in Thailand by displacement background

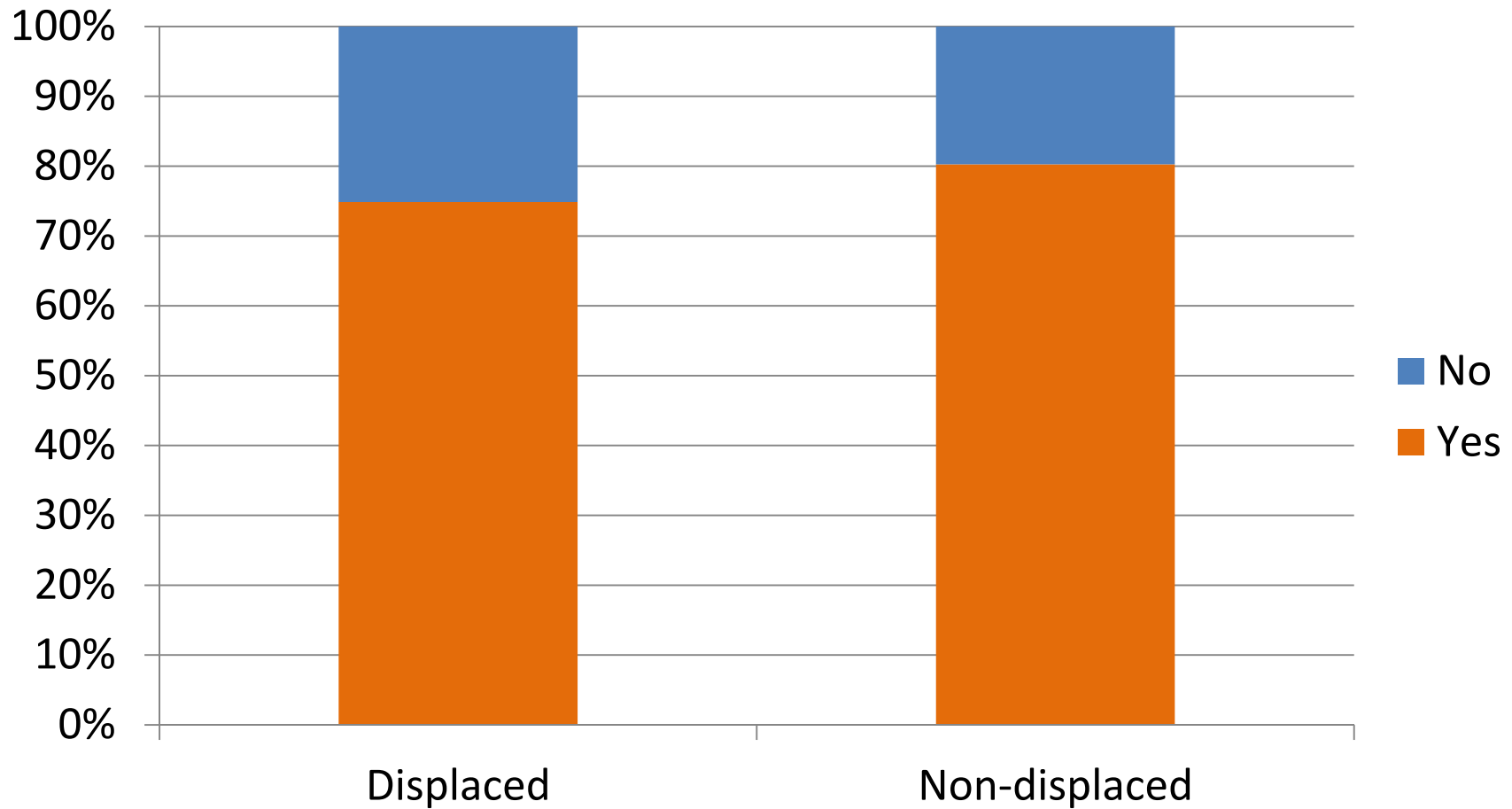


Level of annual remittances in USD

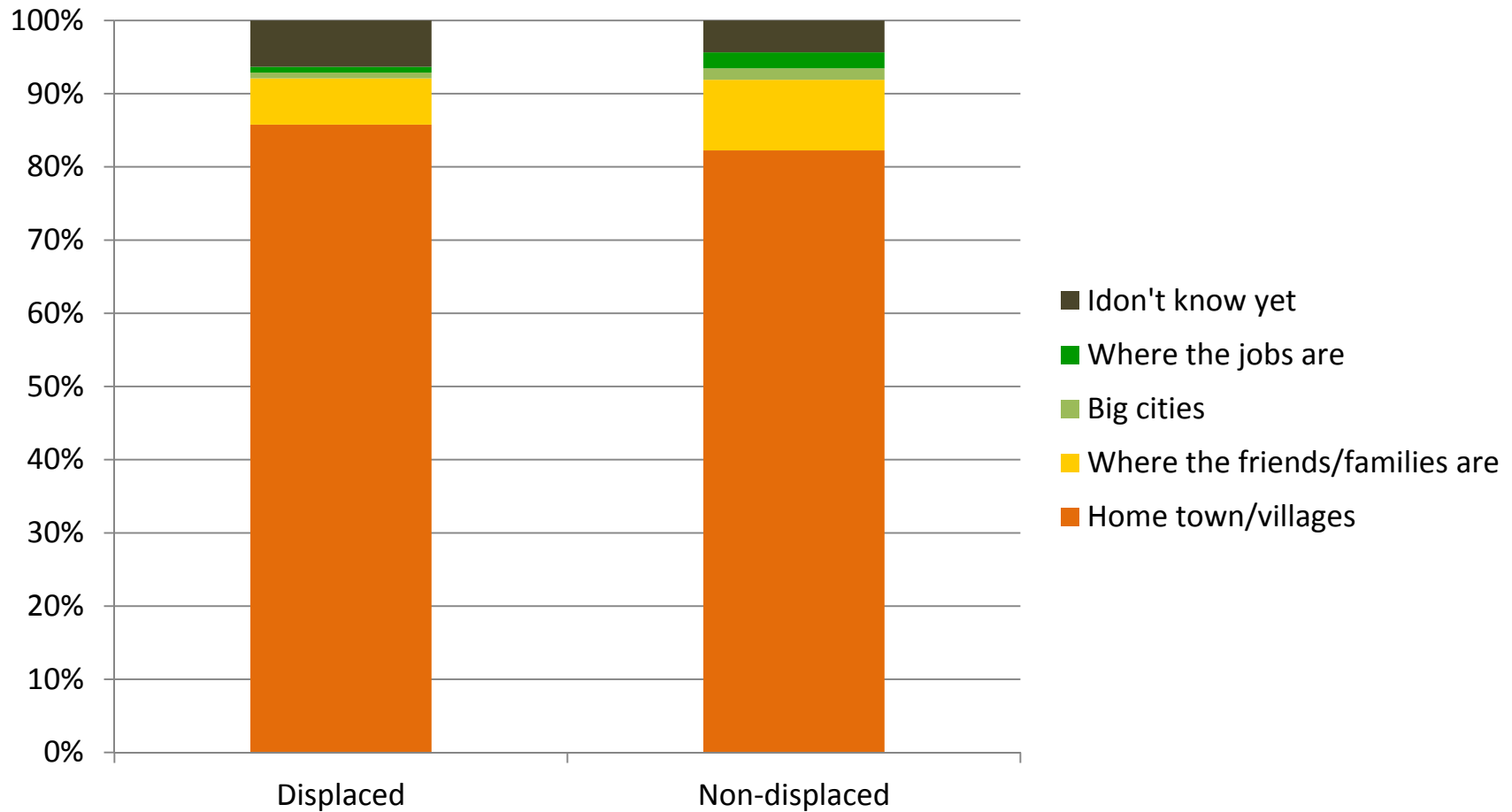

Preferred destination of return by displacement background

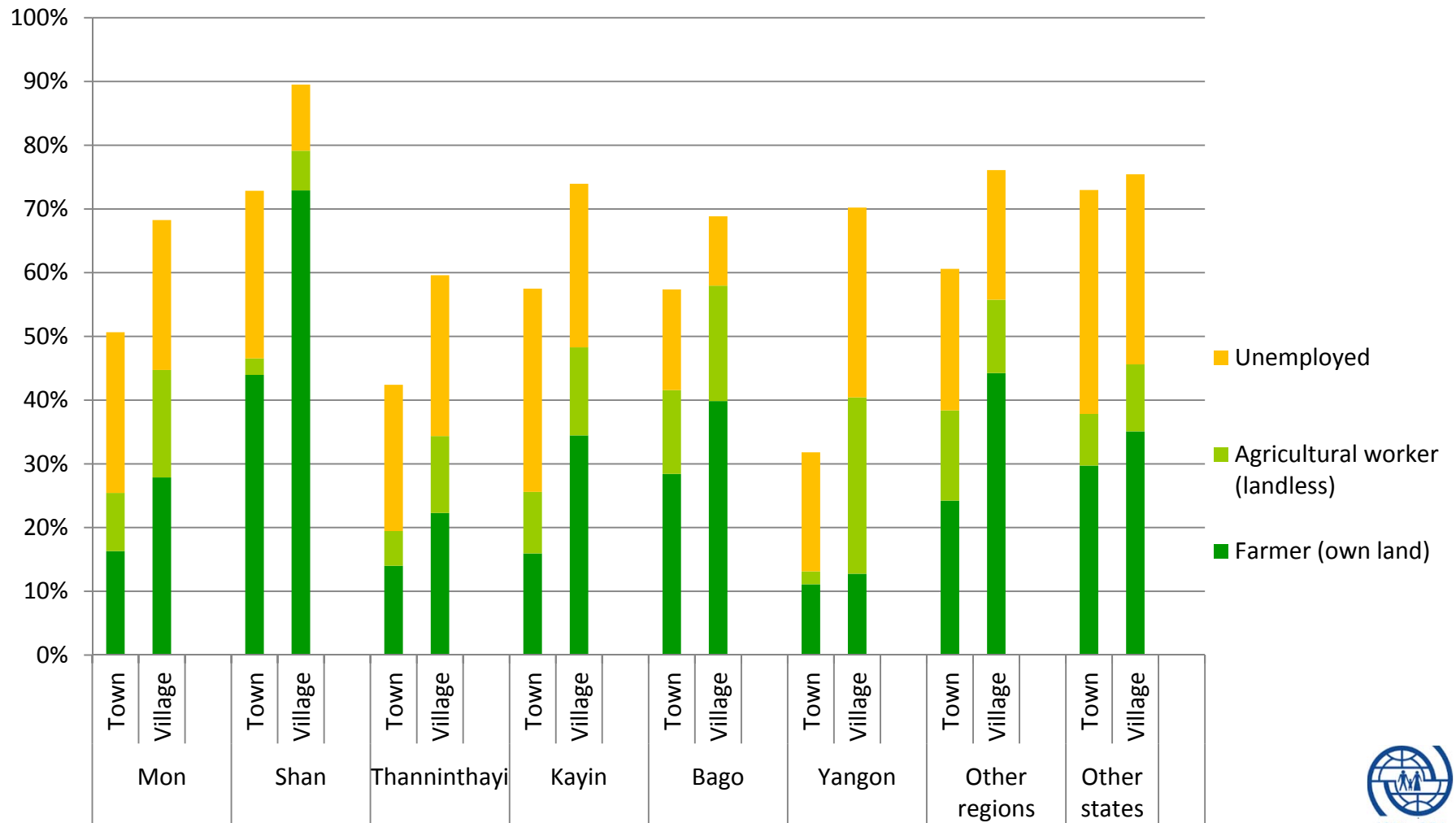


Livelihoods in Myanmar

- **High % of unemployed** in both urban and rural areas, lower in Shan rural areas
- **Lower % of farmers** in Mon, Thanintharyi and Kayin
- **Higher % of landless farmers among farmer populations** in Mon, Thanintharyi and Kayin

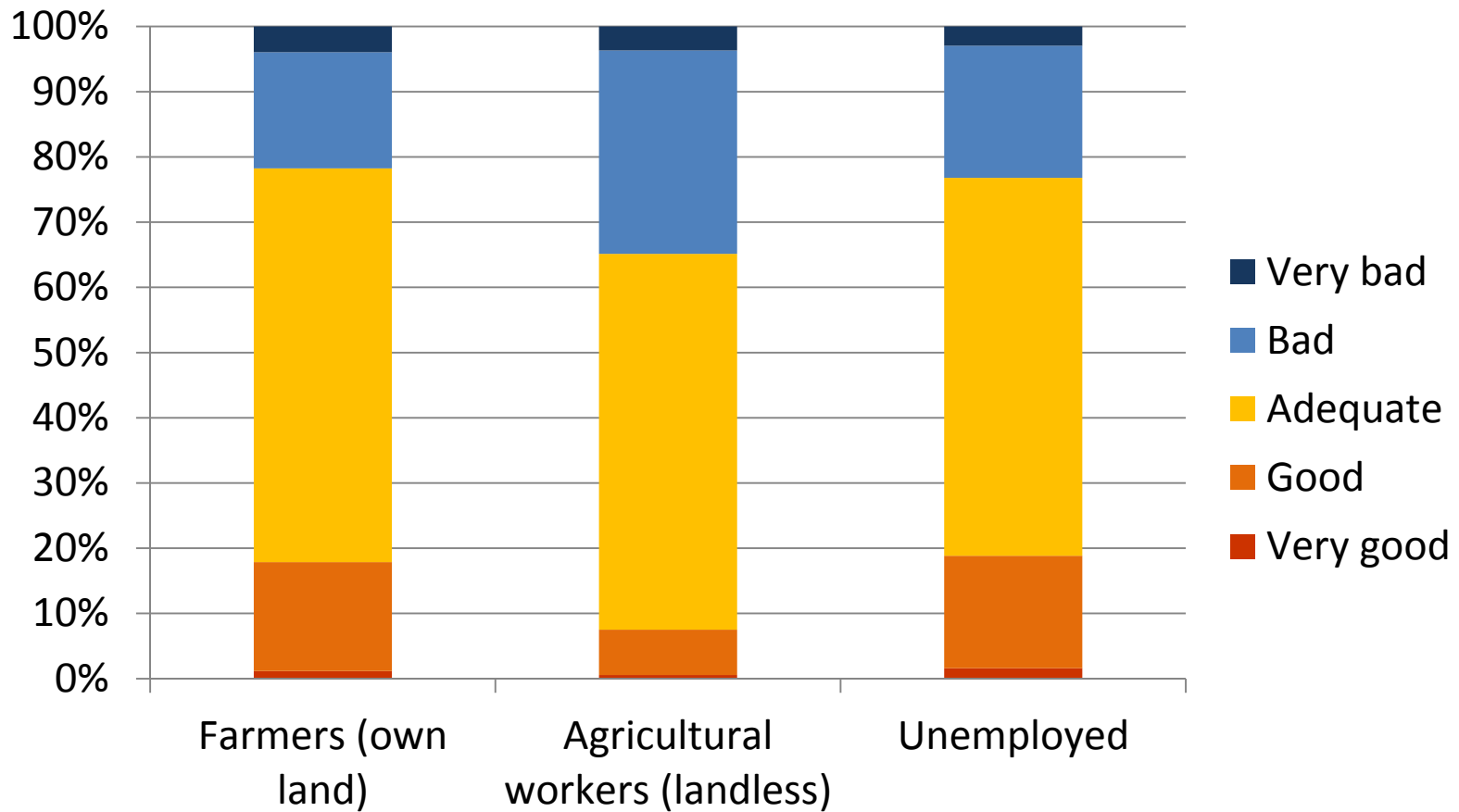
Employment prior to migration

by origin state/region



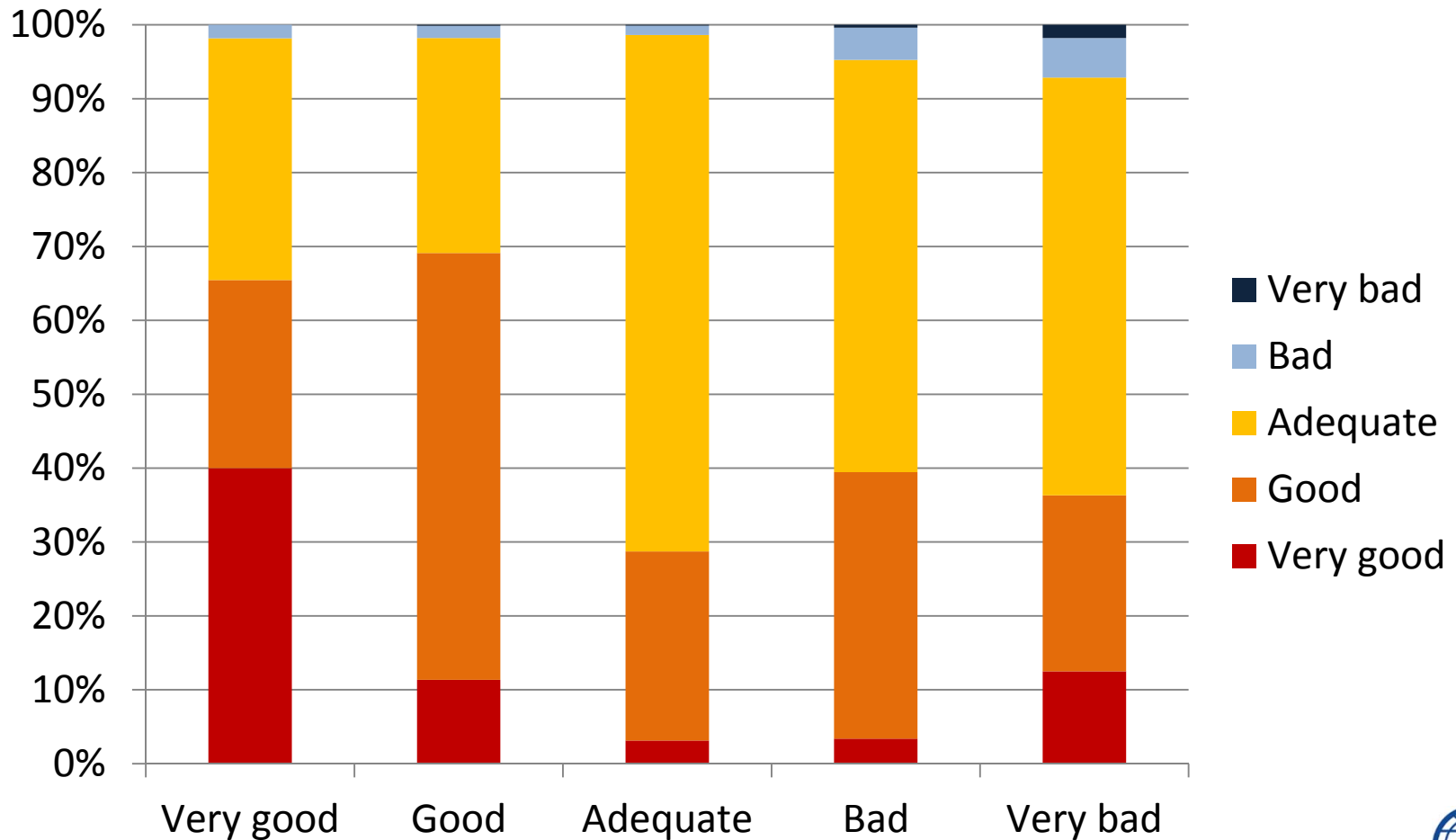
Standard of living prior to migration

Remittances flow

- Average **962 USD/annum**, median **781 USD/annum**, migrants from **Shan** send **less**
- Nationally **1.7 billion USD/annum**, but **1.4 billion** goes to the **South East and Shan**
- **83%** of remittance flow is **through unofficial channels**

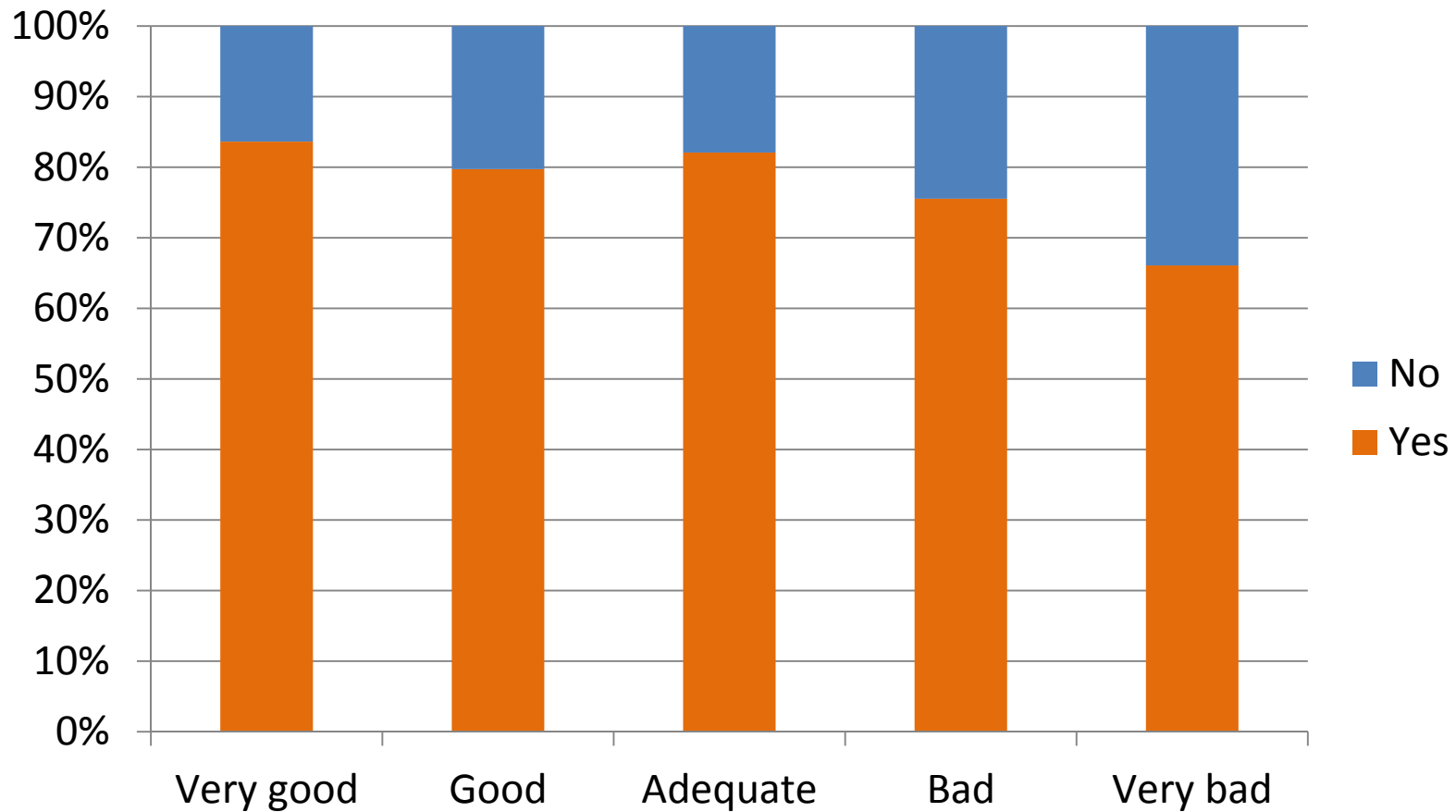

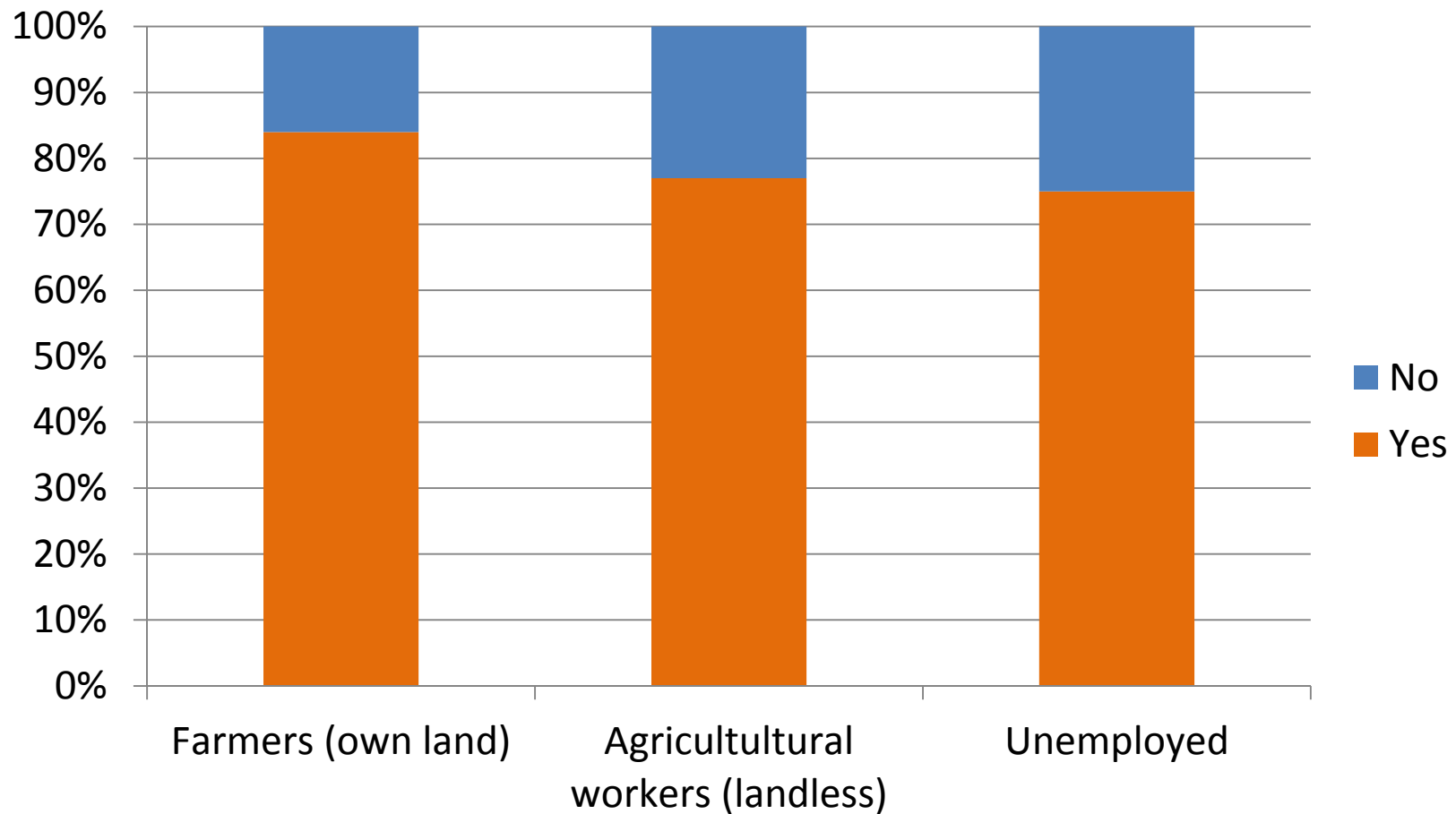
Willingness to return

Skills gained during migration

- **74% female** and **72% male** gained technical skills
- Variety of **attitude skills** including self-confidence
- **48%** thinks the skills gained will **help them find jobs** in Myanmar, **27%** not sure
