II. Objective

- 2. Outcome: The capacitated LGBTQ+ CSOs have successfully delivered locally led SOGIE and Gender Inclusive sub grants achieving SOGIE inclusive humanitarian assistance in Myanmar and border areas. This outcome focuses on the strengthening and capacity building of 12 LGBTQ+ CSOs and groups formed with the support of The LinQ Foundation. These selected LGBTQ+ CSOs will receive training, technical support and mentoring to be better equipped to identify needs and deliver services addressing them in their communities.
