**Job purpose:**

The Project Manager will need to lead the SRHR project implementation under SRHR program with guidance of the Deputy Programme Manager (SRHR) and direct report to Program Unit Manager. S/he will play a key role in implementation and coordinating with local implementation partners and ensures that the project portfolio is well planned, evidence based, monitored and evaluated. S/he will also lead in developing the capabilities of partner staffs to support the achievement of program goals. The Project Manager will play a leading role in CSE curriculum delivery, communication and coordination with partners and country office, budget report, project implementation, monitoring and evaluation and organizational representation as necessary.

The project based at Myitkyina /Waing Maw /Putao & Chipwe in Kachin State and will require frequent travel to the project areas. The post holder will be working closely with the local implementing partners and lead to ensure smooth implementation in terms of providing necessary technical and project management support to them. S/he will need to communicate security and incident issue happen in the project target areas to PUM to get support.

### **Key Responsibilities:**

- Report to the Program Unit Manager and coordinate with Deputy Program Manager (SRHR) of Plan International Myanmar, Country Office lead on the implementation of detailed project activities under HER project and develop good relations and partnership with implementing partners.
- Ensure roll out of the project activities in cooperation with IP and provide technical and programmatic supports as necessary.
- Leads to ensure quality delivery, implementation and management of the project.
- Ensure detailed and timely collection of quality progress and financial reports and good activity photos from the partners.
- Monitor project activities by the partners and progress report and inform encountered on ground challenges to the Deputy Program Manager (SRHR) in a timely manner.
- Lead and maintain partnership management and capacity strengthening of the IPs.
- Lead and facilitate in learning and knowledge management.
- Representation at local and international level as necessary.

### **Qualifications, Skills & Experience:**

- Health-related bachelor degree preferably who had working experiences in sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR) projects with emphasis on Comprehensive Sexuality Education (CSE).
- Strong understanding of gender equality and social inclusion.
- Minimum 3 years of demonstrated professional experience working with similar projects in SRHR and gender.
- Proven track record in delivering high quality health projects, providing trainings, awareness raising, monitoring and supervision
- Experience working with children and young people.
- Strong experience in assessing, building capacity, monitoring and cooperating with local NGOs/ Ethnic Health Organizations (EHOs) and partners and good knowledge of community development in respective project areas of Myanmar.
- Ability to speak Myanmar Language fluently.
- Strong English skills, preferably with good local dialect of the respective project communities.
- Ability to work and travel in an ethnic area, experience working with mixed and diverse population and conflict affected environment.
- Integrity and excellent interpersonal skills including communication, facilitation and team building skills.
- Understands organizational safeguarding and gender policies.
- Reflects on their value system and takes account of their biases towards individuals (including children and young people) in all their diversity.
- Understands the relevance of safeguarding to their work.
- Challenges inappropriate behaviors of peers.
- Able to implement safeguarding requirements in their area of responsibility.
- Acts as a role model for the organization's commitment to non-discrimination, safeguarding and safeguarding standards
