Overall Objectives (scope)

To assist Mobile Nurse, and Midwife for smoothly Health and Nutrition program at the field level under supervision of Nurse and Medical Officer.

Accountable for Health education sessions in the communities/camps with the guidance of Medical Officer.

Accountable for client registration, record client information in patient record books during mobile clinic.

To assist for mobile clinics activities and prepare and arrange for mobile clinic activities collaborate with medical mobile team.

Accountable for communication with the village/camp leader, CBOs, CSOs for smoothly program implementation for health and nutrition activities.

To assist the mobile Nurse and Midwife for conducting trainings, meetings, workshops related Health and Nutrition.

Your responsibilities will be:

- To conduct Health and Nutrition awareness raising session under guidance and supporting of Medical Officer.
- To assist Medical Officer and medical team for organizing community volunteers, community focal points, and peer educators.
- Accountable for improving health knowledge among communities and vulnerable people, by using with IEC material.
- To collaborate with medical team developing IEC designs and IEC distribution in the communities.
- To develop workplan for health awareness raising session in monthly basics in coordination with team members.
- Supervision and training to the community volunteers, and to assist identifying the emergency clients and assist and support for referral cases.

- Keeping the documents, photos of awareness raising session, trainings and meetings and support to volunteers to keep documents, photos of awareness raising sessions.
- Establish good relationship with RI team and CSOs, CBOs
- Attend meeting and review workshops if need.
- Any other task as requested by Medical Officer.

- Able to work under little supervision to complete tasks with timely manner.
