#### Your responsibilities will be:

- Drive RI Speed Boat in difficult security environments
- Spends more than 50% of his time on field trips.
- Checks the mechanical condition of the boat before the trip, ensures that all materials, fuel and equipment for the trips.
- Transports cargo and ensures that the load is secure as per the vehicle specifications in a proper and safe way.
- Is responsible for goods documentation.
- Inform superior about service, maintenance and other possible repairs needed in advance.
- Provides support to the loading and unloading of the boat.
- Is present at the loading and unloading of goods and check that the quantity corresponds with relevant documentation.
- During the trips monitor all cabin instruments to be able to promptly react if needed.
- Is aware of, and reacts to current security situation.
- Ensure daily tidal awareness and update on weather forecast before trips.
- Checks equipment on attributed Vehicle/boat, ensure proper fulling and cleaning.
- Checks the manifest/field trip form against the passengers and on board.

You will bring the following experience and skills.

- Valid boat licence and light vehicle licence.
- Substantial proven experience working in driving boat operations
- Must has as good skill in swimming and all related water lifesaving qualification.
- Basic conversational English and Myanmar.

- Basic mechanical skills, especially for Suzuki OBM engine.
- Very good knowledge of the geographically assigned environment and ocean condition, including reefs.
