- Assess the design and operational capacity of the national and grant-level M&E systems, including data flow, data collection tools, and reporting mechanisms.
- Conduct in-depth verification of programmatic results reported in the PUDR, validating data against source documents at various levels of the health system.
- Provide strategic analysis on program quality and efficiency, identifying the root causes
 of implementation bottlenecks and proposing practical, corrective actions.
- Review and advise on the adequacy of the PR's responses to findings from the Technical Review Panel (TRP).

Minimum Qualifications and Experience

- An advanced degree (Master's or higher) in Public Health, Epidemiology, International Development, or a related field.
- Extensive experience in monitoring and evaluation of large-scale health programs, particularly for HIV, TB, Malaria, or Health Systems Strengthening (HSS).

- A good knowledge of the national and regional health context and experience with Global Fund grants management requirements
- Proven ability to conduct data quality assessments (DQAs) and programmatic spot checks.
