Designing IEC materials (2 Posters)

Background

Voluntary Service Overseas (VSO) is a leading international development organization which promote a world without poverty and working through volunteering approach to share skills and knowledge for development. VSO Myanmar will be providing technical support on gender and disability inclusion to a consortium unit of Multi-Year Resilience Program (MYRP) for Myanmar to achieve its four outcomes specifically on access, quality, system strengthening and resource mobilisation. The main objective of MYRP in Myanmar is to provide quality education services to the most vulnerable learners, including children with disabilities, and those out-of-school or at risk of dropping out in a safe disability inclusive and gender responsive, and protective learning environment.

In this regard, VSO is looking for an experienced graphic illustration artist who can represent the messages of project needs through compelling visual designs based on the content and guidance provided by the project team. The qualified service provider is expected to design IEC materials which primarily aimed at various target audiences. The service provider shall be responsible to provide standardized materials by ensuring quality and appropriate creation to promote positive behaviour change in the project's target communities. Due to the nature of the project, we are seeking for a service provider that can complete the assignment within 1 month or the stipulated timeline set by VSO.

Scope of Work

- Develop 2 posters with key messages given by VSO to raise awareness on gender and disability inclusion in learning environment.
- Dimensions of poster size is 2 ft x 3 ft and develop 6-9 characters for a poster.
- Develop the materials following accessible and inclusive communications guidelines.
- Open to collaborating with VSO project team to ensure the poster aligns with our vision and requirements.
- Must ensure full compliance of graphic and visual communication products with the relevant graphic standard and the VSO brand guidelines.
- Revise for minor adjustment and edition to the designs upon the project team request.
- The service provider is responsible for all software and hardware required to compete the projects.

- Ensure to use copyrighted characters/objects in posters by own creative.
- Any material submitted under this ToR is the property of VSO and the project. It cannot be submitted or distributed to or used by any other agencies without prior informed consent.

Payment will be processed based on deliverables as agreed in the contract document. It
will be made upon receipt of agreed final version of the products in the standard format
and guidelines.
