What you will do

- Line management for support staff at Area Field Offices (Finance, HR & Admin, Logistics, ICT, and Security)
- Member of the Area Management Team (AMT)
- Compliance with and adherence to NRC policies, guidance and handbooks, and donor/auditor requirements
- Provide input on operational support to Area Strategy, and to coordinate and align operational support with program plans
- Responsible for implementation of new country specific technical SOPs, guidelines and tools in Area Field Offices (Finance, HR & Admin, Logistics, ICT, and Security)
- Coordinate and assist with budgets and costs for Area Field Offices' shared costs and support functions
- Provide support in the training and development of Area Field Office staff
- Coordinate and cooperate with NRC stakeholders (government, UN, INGO/NGO/CBO) and relevant partners, according to strategy and plans
- Complete regular reports on functional responsibilities to Area Manager and Country
 Office
- Promote the rights of IDPs/returnees in line with the advocacy strategy.

- Knowledge of the context in Northeast Myanmar
