Under the supervision of Project Coordinator, Nutrition Promotor will implement for the rollout of nutrition SBCC (Social and Behavior change Communication) strategy in selected townships.

Key Responsibilities

- ❖ Conduct village level advocacy meeting to introduce the project with key stakeholders.
- ❖ Assist to Project Coordinators in developing village profile to identify nutritional vulnerabilities and map the potential target groups.
- ❖ Assist to Project Coordinators in selection of nutrition volunteers.
- ❖ Train the nutrition volunteers.
- ❖ Establish the MtMSG in all project targeted villages.
- ❖ Conduct monthly Social Behavior Change Communication (SBCC) sessions with nutrition modules.
- ❖ Distribute IEC materials such as pamphlets, posters, leaflets etc.
- ❖ Identify the major barriers to behavior change among PLW to adjust SBCC approaches (Feedback mechanism)
- ❖ Mobilize and strengthen the capacity of PLW to serve as peer educators to disseminate key messages.
- ❖ Develop successful case studies, case histories, success stories among the targeted groups.
- ❖ Conduct participatory cooking demonstration sessions with PLW, women and relevant change agents.
- ❖ Conduct cooking competition activities.
- ❖ Assist to Project Coordinators in consultation sessions with targeted beneficiaries and other key stakeholders to identify the relevant nutrition sensitive package.

Skill and Requirement

- ❖ Any degree prefer bachelor degree and professional experiences in nutrition, ideally IYCF promotion.
- ❖ Capacity to work in remote areas with difficult access in volatile security environments.
- ❖ Experiences in organizing, planning and implementation in training of volunteers.
