Position Summary

Under the overall supervision of the Project Manager and direct supervision of the Medical Officer (Team Leader), the Nurse will provide high-quality nursing care according to standardized treatment guidelines and ensure the delivery of high-quality services at all services delivery points. He/she needs to support project-related activities of Integrated MNCH including mobile clinic projects.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

Project Implementation

- ❖ To assist the medical doctor in giving general clinical care to IDPs (Women and Under 5).
- ❖ To administer and dispense drugs as prescribed by the Medical Doctor and ensure that the patient is clear on how to take the medication and aware of potential side effects.
- ❖ To provide proper nursing care to the patients in the primary health care setting.
- To always follow strict infection control measures. (i.e., hand hygiene, the use of gloves and respirator masks, non-touch aseptic techniques, waste management)
- To keep records, registers, and patients' data systematically and respect confidentiality.
- Support activities for emergency referral patients.
- ❖ To assist and facilitate the medical doctor (Team Leader) in Training sessions to community-based health workers at field sites.
- ❖ To ensure triage of patients and arrange patient flow in the waiting area in collaboration with Volunteers and health promoters.
- * Report tour program and trip plan to Medical Officer in advance.
- ❖ To check and fill mobile drug stocks before mobile clinic sessions and act as focal person for medicine and equipment for the mobile trip, coordinating with Logistic assistant.
- ❖ To ensure compliance with infection prevention guidelines with every client and every service.
- To perform other functions as assigned.

Skill and Requirement

- ❖ Health-related degree (or)Bachelor in Nursing (or) diploma in Nurse (or) Midwife, valid license to practice in Myanmar.
- At least 1-year experience in related field.
- Person with knowledge on the local language (Kayin) is preferable.
- Must be able to travel with car without any physical difficulties (i.e. frequent motion sickness sufferer is not suitable.
- ❖ Ability to travel to field sites (Project Areas) frequently is essential.
- Experience in organizing, planning and implementing in training of volunteers
- Must have computer skills in MS office.

- Ability to work systematically, accurately, independently and under pressure in a physically challenging environment.
- Flexibility ability to work with multi-disciplinary and multi-cultural people, open- minded, good communication skills, ability to listen and diplomacy.
- Good interpersonal communication skills.
