




Number of ppl Covered against 2021 HRP targets (IDPs- protracted+new displacement)



Cumulative Funding Received/Gap as of 2021-Q3(US\$)







HRP5: Number of women, men, girls and boys accessing WASH services in temporary health facilities and learning spaces which received support from the WASH Cluster




- 5,008 students have access to functional water points in temporary learning spaces and child friendly spaces
- 9,700 students have access to functioning school latrines
- 600 people have access to functioning latrines in temporary health care facilities
- Regular hygiene promotion sessions are decreased to adopt social distancing and to avoid crowded people in the camps as part of covid-19 prevention but covid-19 hygiene awareness with loud speakers are continuing.










Latrine Target and Reached




Average functioning adult latrine Usage (#PPL:1latrine)




% of People feel safe to use latrines when they need to (or at day/night)






