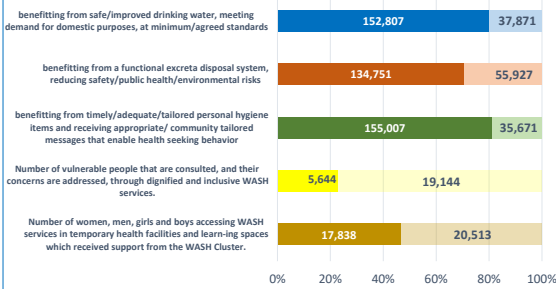
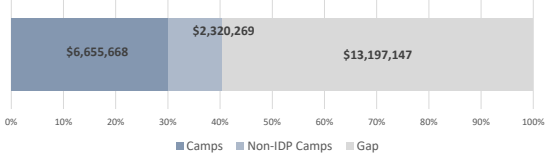


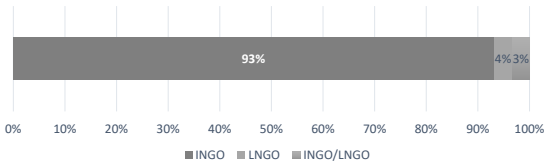
### Number of ppl Covered against 2021 HRP targets (IDPs- protracted+new displacement)

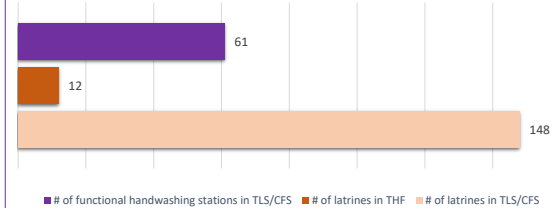

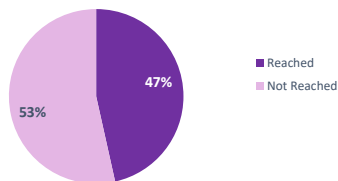

### HRP5: Number of women, men, girls and boys accessing WASH services in temporary health facilities and learn-ing spaces which received support from the WASH Cluster

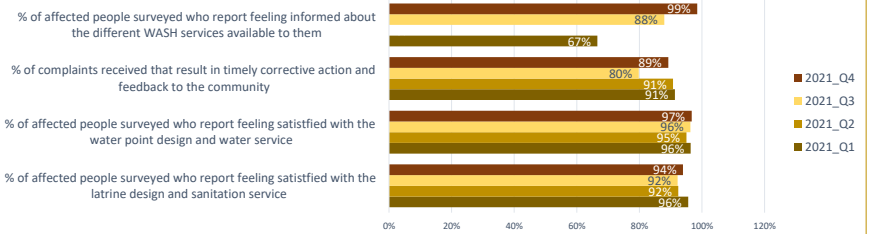


1. 5,008 students have access to functional water points in temporary learning spaces and child friendly spaces
2. 9,700 students have access to functioning school latrines
3. 600 people have access to functioning latrines in temporary health care facilities
4. Regular hygiene promotion sessions are decreased to adopt social distancing and to avoid crowded people in the camps as part of covid-19 prevention but covid-19 hygiene awareness with loud speakers are continuing.

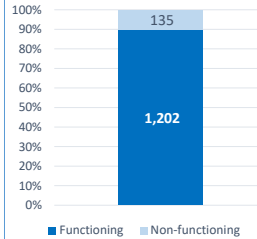

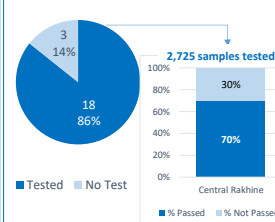

#### # of improved water points functioning and non-functioning

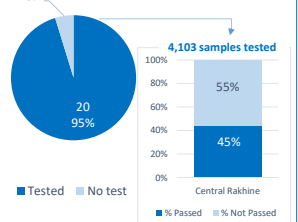


#### % of Sites which made water quality test at water sources as of Q4-2021



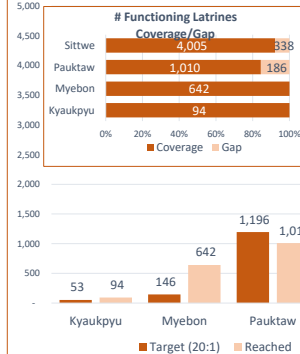

#### % of Sites which made water quality test at household as of Q4-2021

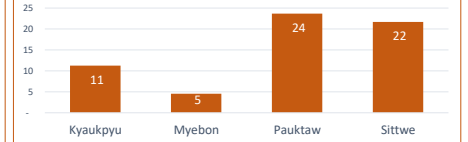

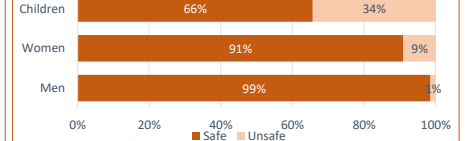
#### Latrine Target and Reached



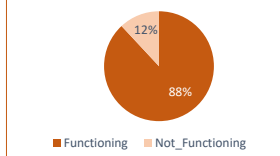
#### Average functioning adult latrine Usage (#PPL:1latrine)



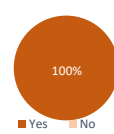
#### % of People feel safe to use latrines when they need to (or at day/night)



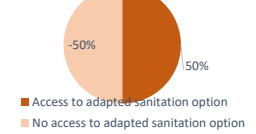

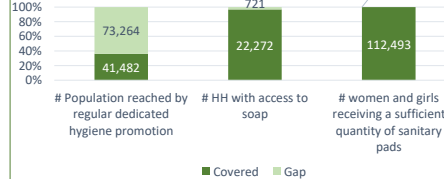

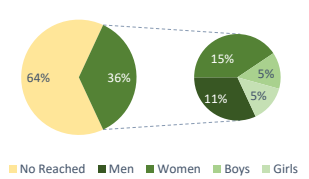

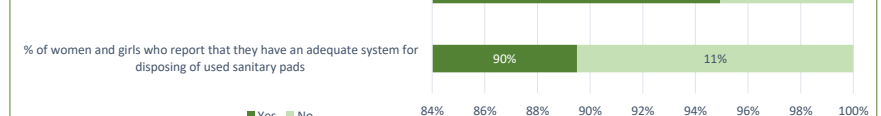
