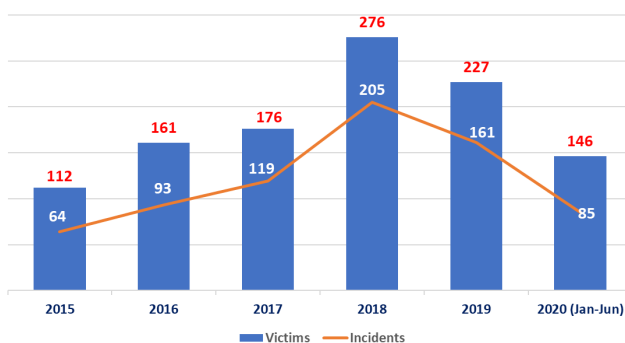
Situation Figures (2015—2020)

727 total number of incidents

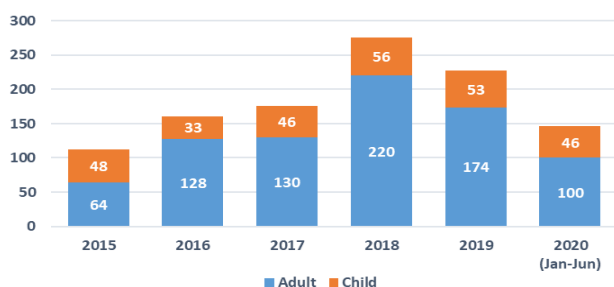
1,098 total number of casualties (including 259 death)

44% of total casualties were women and children

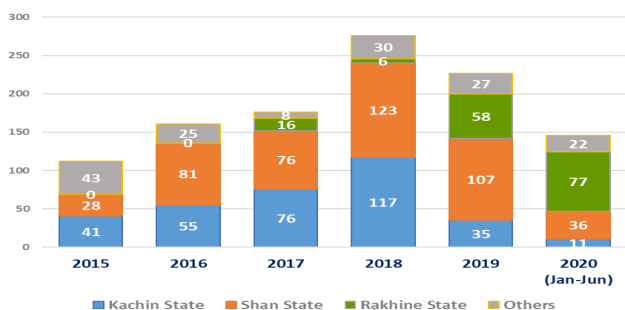
Number of incidents and victims (Countrywide)



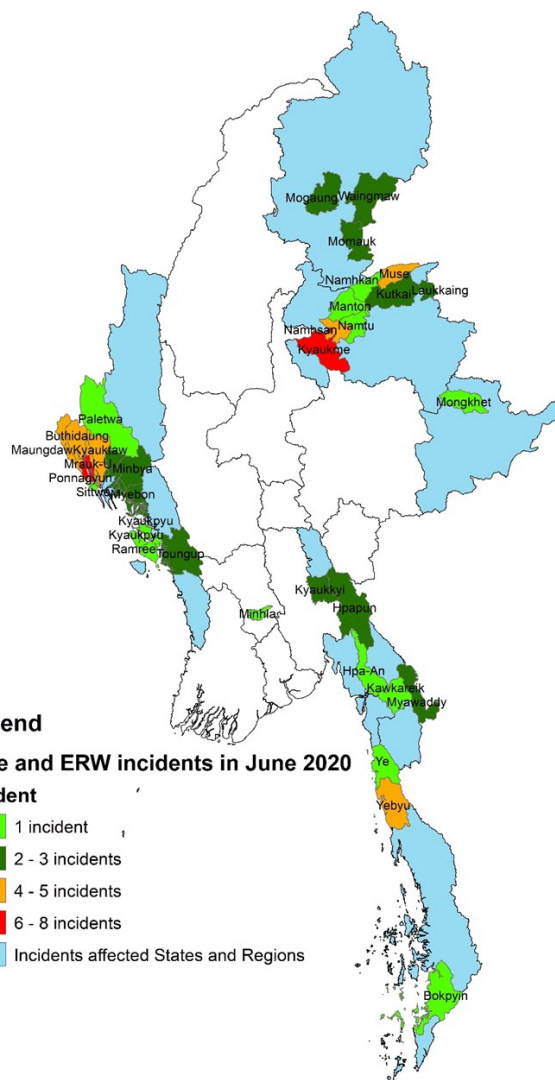
Number of victims (Countrywide)

During the first six months of 2020, Mine Risk Working Group (MRWG) documented 146 casualties, 47% were women and children. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, face to face EORE activities were limited. Mine Action actors used the alternative way to reach EORE messages to the communities such as radio transmission and mobile application.

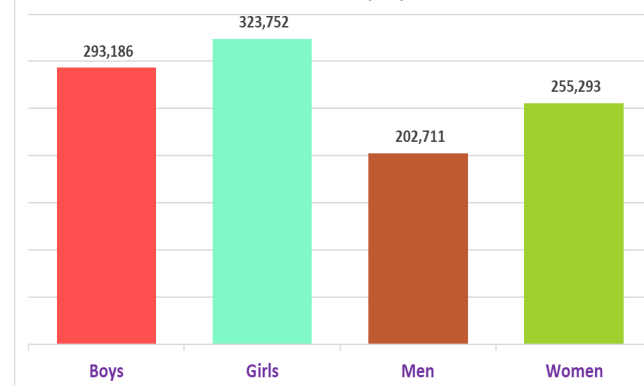
Response Figures
