

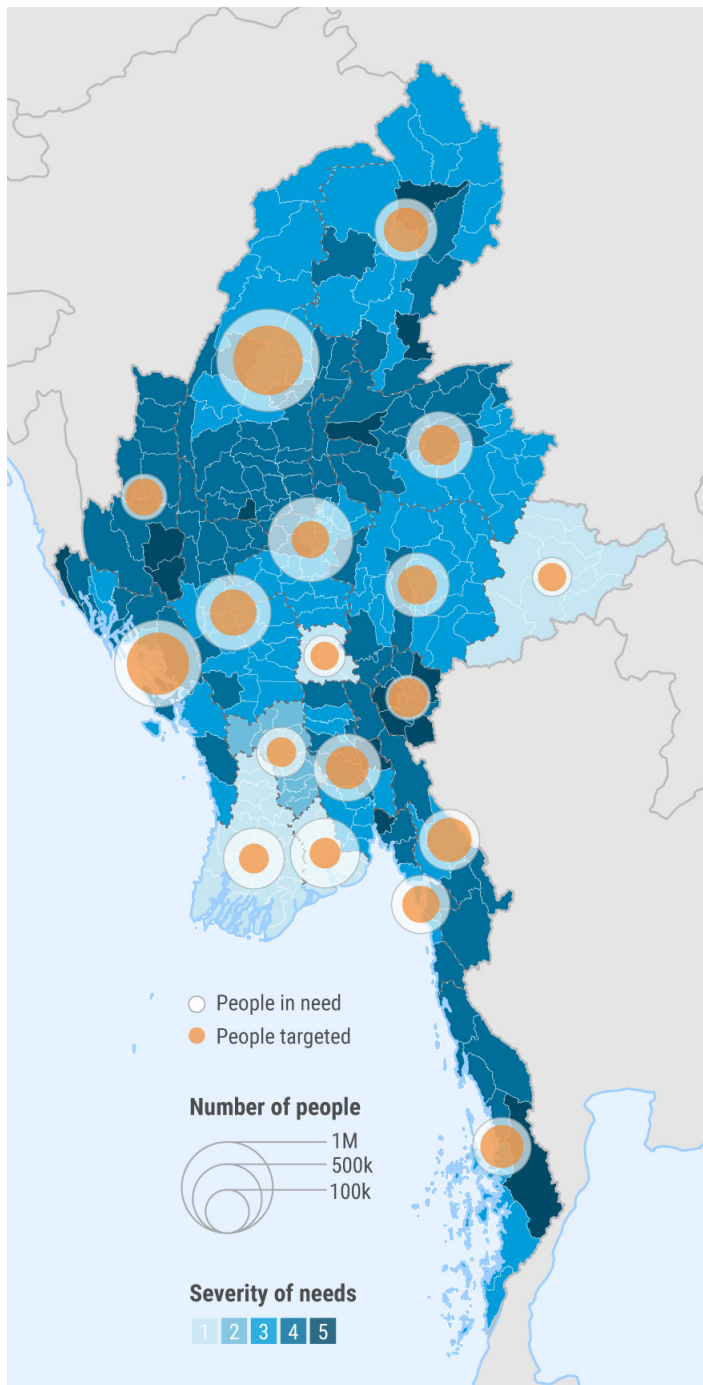

Cluster objectives and activities:

CO1: Evolving protection concerns, needs, and violations are monitored, analyzed, and responded to through multilayered protection response, upholding fundamental rights and restoring the dignity, physical safety and well-being of affected populations. (Monitoring and Response)

CA1: Cash assistance part of GBV case management.

CA2: GBV case management and psychosocial support.

CA3: Provision of safe house/shelter service.

CA4: Provision of Legal aid/counselling.

CO2: A conducive environment to prevent and mitigate protection risks and concerns is supported through inclusive, localized community protection approaches, mainstreaming of protection and enhancement of capacity of protection and non-protection actors to address the impacts of armed conflict and other shocks on civilians. (Risk mitigation and prevention)

CA5: Distribution of dignity kits and cash and voucher assistance.

CA6: GBV outreach and awareness raising.

CA7: Primary GBV prevention.

CA8: Capacity building of frontline workers.

CA9: Capacity building of community mobilizers.

CA10: Capacity building of CSO/WLOs on GBV prevention and response, and coordination.

CA11: Capacity building of non-GBV humanitarian actors on GBV risk mitigation and safe referrals.

CO3: Cluster coordination and information management are strengthened at all levels.

CA12: GBV safety audits.

CA13: Dedicated cluster coordination and information management by six staff members: 1 national coordinator, 1 national IMO, 4 subnational co-coordinators (Women Led Organizations/ CSOs).
