

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,038,900 last week to 1,039,000 this week.

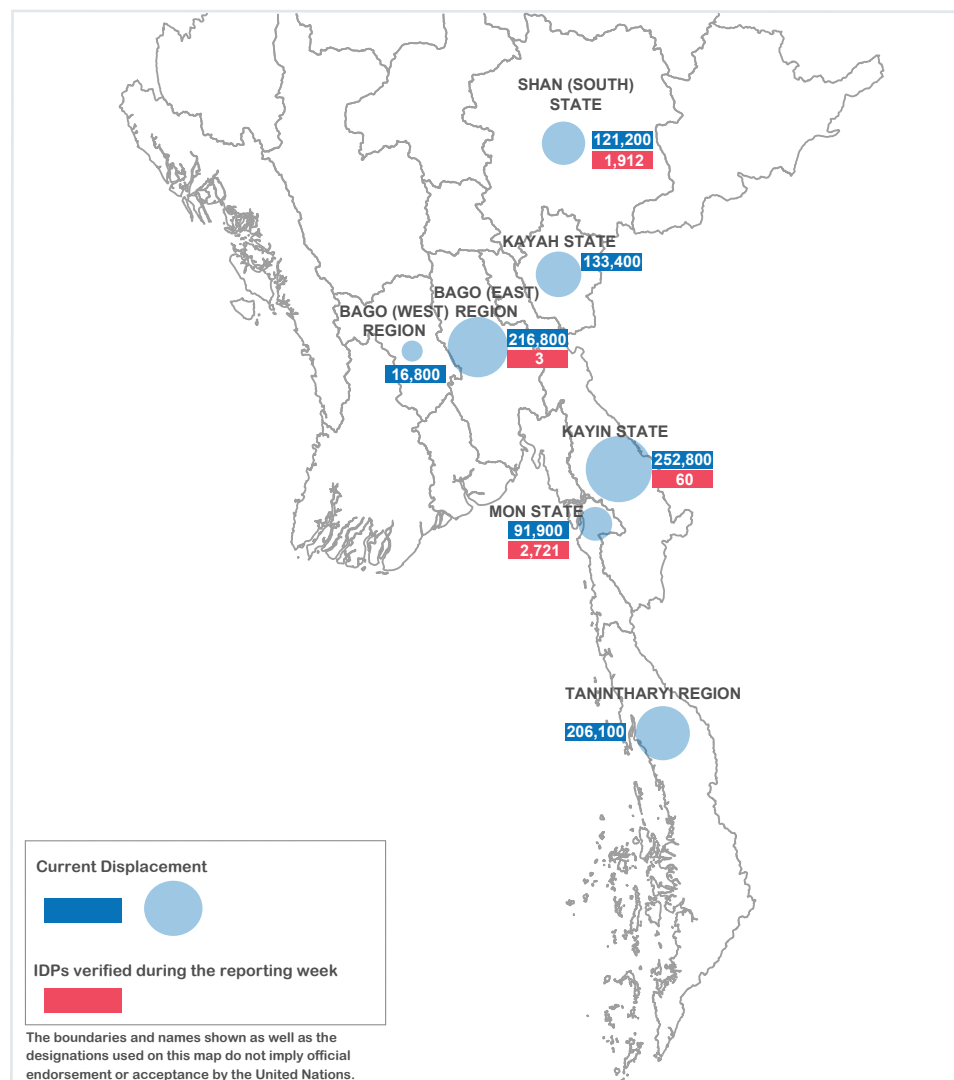
In Kayin State, the conflict is escalating in the Kyondoe area, Kawka-reik Township, resulting in the displacement of an estimated 60 people from Yae Kyaw Gyi, Kawka-reik Township, who fled to Hpa-An Township due to continued airstrikes and indiscriminate shelling along the Kyondoe-Kawka-reik Highway Road.

In Mon State, 721 people from Baw Ka Hta, Kyaikto Township, were newly displaced, and 2,000 IDPs from Win Kan, Kyaikto Township, have been displaced for the second time within the same township due to artillery shelling and drone strikes.

In Bago East, 3 people from 20 Mile, Oktwin Township, have been displaced within the same township due to intensified clashes, including indiscriminate shelling by the Tatmadaw.

In Shan State (South), 1,434 IDPs from Yae Pu, Nyaungshwe Township, have been displaced for the second time to Pekon and Taunggyi Townships due to armed clashes and airstrikes. Additionally, 1,190 IDPs from Hsihseng Town reportedly returned to their places of origin within the same township as armed clashes have temporarily subsided.

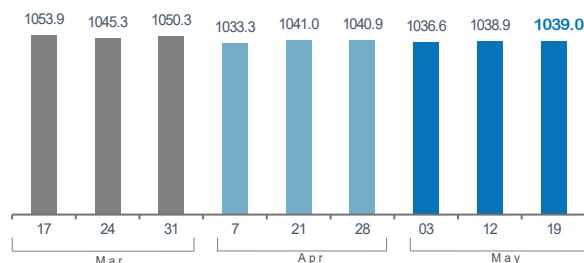
