
## **WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS**


In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,039,000 last week to 1.039,200 this week.


In Kayin State, the conflict continues to escalate in the Kyondoe area, Kawkareik Township, resulting in the displacement of 849 people from Yae Kyaw Gyi, Kawkareik Township to Hpa-An Township due to ongoing airstrikes and shelling along the Kyondoe-Kawkareik Highway. Additionally, 183 people from the same area have been displaced for a second time to Thar Ma Nya, Hpa-An Township. 130 people from Taw Pyar Gyi, Thandaunggyi Township, have also been displaced within the same township due to shelling by the Tatmadaw.

In Mon State, 502 people from Win Kan, Kyaikto Township have been displaced for the second time within the same township due to artillery shelling and drone strikes. In Bago East, 17 people from 20 Mile, Oktwin Township were displaced within the same township, and 16 people from Si Paing, Yedashe Township were newly displaced to Hswar Town due to intensified clashes and indiscriminate shelling by the Tatmadaw.

In Shan State (South), 1,599 people from Hsawng Pyaung, Pinlaung Township were newly displaced within the same township due to armed clashes. Additionally, 1,675 IDPs from Mese Township and 450 IDPs from Shadaw Township reportedly returned to their places of origin within the same townships.
