

WEEKLY HIGHLIGHTS

In the South-East, the number of IDPs increased from 1,045,300 last week to 1,046,300 this week.

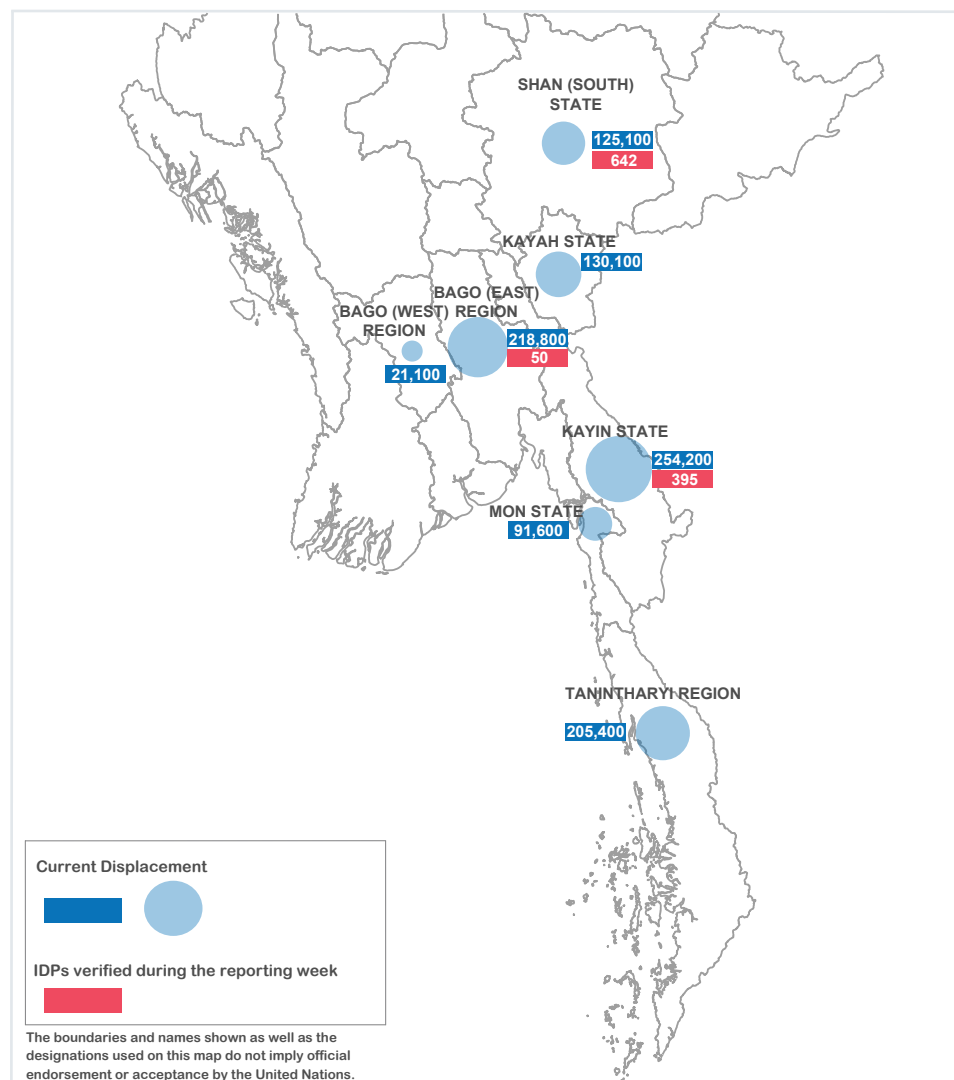
In Bago East, 50 people from Shwegyin Township were newly displaced within the same township due to the Tatmadaw troop movement into the village.

In Kayin State, 43 people from Hpapun Township were newly displaced within the same township (to Kamarmaung Town) due to intensified clashes, and 352 people from Kawkareik Town were displaced within the same township due to indiscriminate shelling into the villages by the Tatmadaw.

In Shan State (South), 250 people from Pekon Township were newly displaced within the same township due to intensified clashes and shelling along the border of Pekon and Nyaungshwe Township. Additionally, 392 people from Hsihseng Township were displaced within the same township due to forced displacement from Hsihseng Town by the Ethnic Armed Organizations (EAOs).

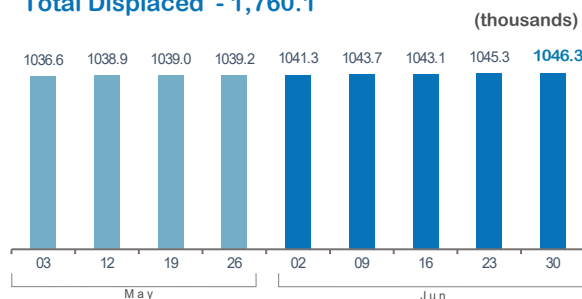
