WHO	<p>190 agencies (76 INGOs, 31 NNGOs, 18 UN agencies, 20 IOs, 14 Donors/Embassies, 31 Others) have recorded their initiatives. 13 agencies have contributed 50% of the assessments, namely UNOPS, RI, IFPRI, SCI, UNFPA, MKE, HELVETAS, MCRB, UNOCHA, UN-Habitat, UNHCR, MIMU and UNDP.</p>

WHERE	<p>40% of assessments are for the Countrywide initiatives, followed by Rakhine (15%), Yangon (12%), Ayeyarwady, Kayin, Mandalay, Mon and Shan (north) (10% in each).
