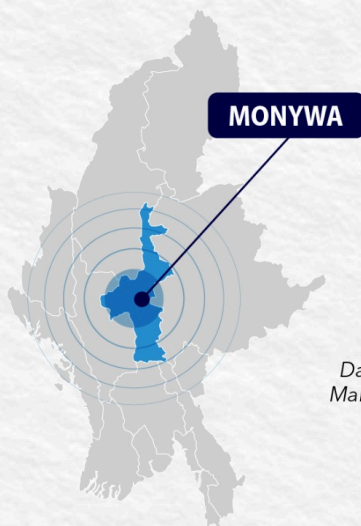
# MYANMAR EARTHQUAKE

### Key Information:

- **A 7.7 - magnitude earthquake** struck Myanmar on March 28, 2025, with the epicenter located in Mandalay and Sagaing.
- **1,644 people have died, 3,408 were injured, and over 200 are reported missing.**
- A state of emergency has been declared in six regions and states, including Naypyidaw, Sagaing Region, Mandalay Region, Magway Region, Northeastern Shan State, and Bago Region.
- Myanmar has requested international assistance and ASEAN coordination for humanitarian aid.
- Severe infrastructure damage includes airports, bridges, universities, hotels, historical sites, and public services.
- Power and communication networks have been disrupted; many residents are displaced and spending nights on the streets.

### Human Initiative Response:

1. Human Initiative response team has been on the ground since the first night of the earthquake.
2. Reaching severely affected areas in Naypyidaw and Mandalay.
3. Coordinating with local volunteers in Myanmar and Thailand.
4. Collaborating with BNPB (Indonesian National Disaster Management Agency) and the Indonesian Embassy in Yangon.
5. Distributing essential aid to survivors.
6. - Conducting life-saving evacuations.
7. - Carrying out disaster impact assessments.
