# **MYANMAR EARTHQUAKE**

### **Key Information:**


- A 7.7 magnitude earthquake struck Myanmar on March 28, 2025, with the epicenter located in Mandalay and Sagaing.
- 1,644 people have died, 3,408 were injured, and over 200 are reported missing.
- A state of emergency has been declared in six regions and states, including Naypyidaw, Sagaing Region, Mandalay Region, Magway Region, Northeastern Shan State, and Bago Region.
- Myanmar has requested international assistance and ASEAN coordination for humanitarian aid.
- Severe infrastructure damage includes airports, bridges, universities, hotels, historical sites, and public services
- Power and communication networks have been disrupted; many residents are displaced and spending nights on the streets.



















#### **Human Initiative Response:**

- 1. Human Initiative response team has been on the ground since the first night of the earthquake.
- 2. Reaching severely affected areas in Naypyidaw and Mandalay.
- 3. Coordinating with local volunteers in Myanmar and Thailand.
- 4. Collaborating with BNPB (Indonesian National Disaster Management Agency) and the Indonesian Embassy in Yangon.
- 5. Distributing essential aid to survivors.
- 6. Conducting life-saving evacuations.
- 7. Carrying out disaster impact assessments.
