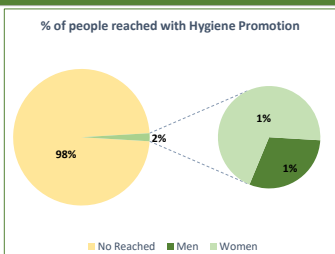
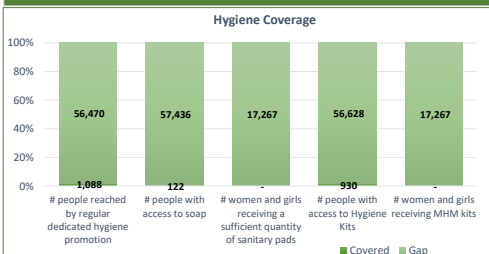


PROTRACTED CAMPS: Sanitation
