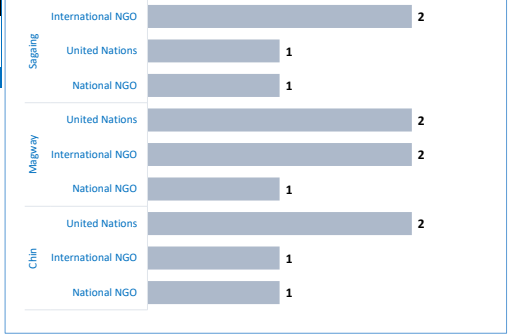

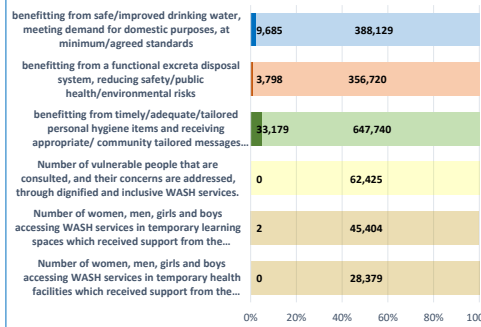

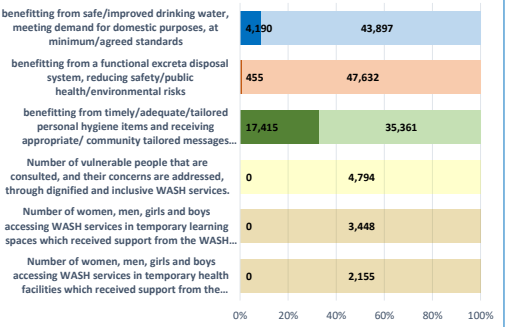

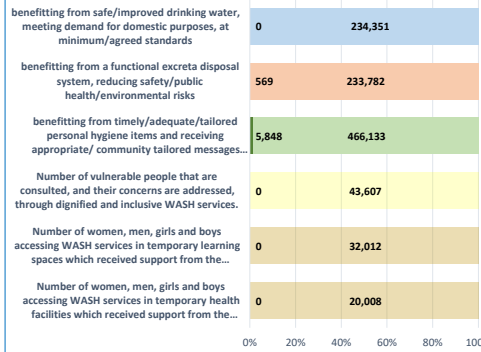
NW :Number of ppl Covered against 2024 HRP targets



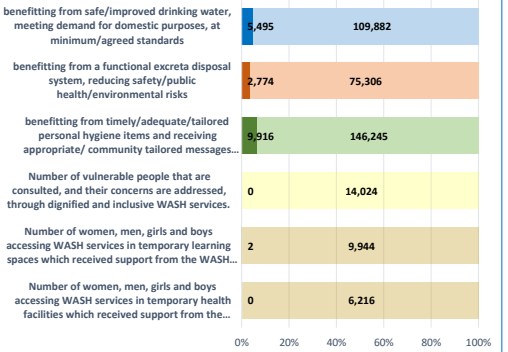
CHIN :Number of ppl Covered against 2024 HRP targets



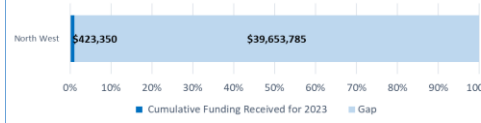
SAGAING : Number of ppl Covered against 2024 HRP targets
