Job purpose

Contributes to the implementation of the Physical Rehabilitation Project activities in accordance to agreed objectives and related strategies, particularly in relation to improved quality and capacity of prosthetics and orthotics (P&O) and wheelchair service provision. As a member of the physical rehabilitation multidisciplinary team, s/he contributes to the implementation of internal and international P&O standards, overall service provision standards and monitor the quality of the services provided (from registration of the service user to discharge). S/he will personally provide services to more complicated/complex cases.

Main responsibilities

- Promotes best practice in coordination with the Physical Rehabilitation team and be actively involved in the delivery of prosthesis, orthoses and wheelchairs services.
- Directly provides P&O service provision as per requirements of the program, including, but not limited to, assessment, casting, fabrication, gait training & finishing.
- Collaborates and liaises with all members of the rehabilitation team to ensure a multidisciplinary team approach.
- Actively participates in the clinical assessments with the physiotherapists to draw an ideal treatment plan.
- Assists centre managers and P&O Head of Department in guidelines implementation in order that standards are respected.
- Supports technical and clinical staff to perform systematic quality control procedures.
- Contributes to the capacity building of partners and other persons involved in the physical rehabilitation program.
- Contributes in monitoring the PRC's stock consumption and actively participates in the planning and ordering of workshop equipment, materials and tools.
- Participates to the further development and training for the repairmen network in Shan State.
- Reports on physical rehabilitation context, needs, and programmes at internal and external level.
- Exercises and promotes standardised best practices in coordination with the PRP team and supports the PRC and Team leader in the implementation of relevant guidelines and standards.
- Ensures workshop machineries are well equipment, maintained, repaired or replaced.
- Ensures respect of safety working procedures
- Collaborates and liaises with all members of the rehabilitation team to ensure a multidisciplinary team approach is harnessed.

Requirements and experience

- Work experience in a relevant field or with NGO/INGO is an asset.
- Higher/bachelor's degree education in Prosthetic and Orthotic. ISPO Category II or equivalent.
- Strong commitment and motivation for humanitarian work and work with People with Disabilities.
