Moreover, she/he has to provide strong advisory roles for the saving and credit mechanism, agricultural value chain and capacity building for producer groups. She/he has responsible to report to Project Manager of CESVI, Technical Specialist from funding agency.

Essential duties and responsibilities of the Assistant Project Manager

- Develop project implementation plan with active participation of the team and in consultation with the Technical Specialist from the fund agency.
- Supervise and advise project staff for implementation on field activities as per milestones and targets.
- Perform saving and credit group and management committee formation and lead the saving and credit mechanism training in the targeted communities.
- Organize community meetings in target villages to set up the group's bylaws, rules and principles.

- Support the establishment of the women-led Agro-processing producer groups, which are integrating with the saving and credit scheme in the targeted area.
- Liaise very closely with all relevant stakeholders to ensure proper interface and congenial relationship between CESVI and stakeholders such as private companies, NGO, service providers and processors, beneficiary groups, other private sectors.
- Technical support to field staff to establish saving and credit activities and actively manage in field-level activities.
- Manage the field survey and assess the existing habits of food, nutrition, post-harvest management practices, and food safety practices in the targeted communities
- Supervise and manage the field activities such as the identification of required trainings for saving and credit group and agro processing group, provide training, delivery of processing kits, operation and maintenance training and project related activities
- Manage training sessions, prepare report for each session and submit to the Project Manager, Programme Manager and funding agency.
- Monitoring on the project activities and sustainable use of the processing equipment/ materials and submit report to Project Manager, Programme Manager and funding agency.
- To communicate with technicians from the funding agency regularly.
- Leading the linkage of financial institutions, machinery service providers, technical service providers, inputs suppliers and better access for improved markets.
- Leading the linkages between processor groups and market actors to access better market platform.
- Submission of deliverables, reports and special event reports to donors.
- Assist to Project Manager in order to prepare interim project progress reports and final narrative report including photo documents.
- To perform any other assignments were given by Head of Mission and Programme Manager.
- Be responsible for managing the Project budgets including regular monitoring of expenditure against budget.
- Support to Project Manager in developing the monthly budget forecast, checking to financial supporting documents and daily supervision of utilizing the project's resources.

Qualification and experiences

- Applicants should have a University Master Degree in Agricultural Economics, Development Studies, Public Administration and Business Administration and other related fields of saving and credit and agro-value chain.
- Applicants must have at least 7-10 years of experience in both the agro-value chain, value added and community-level saving and credit schemes.
- Good communication skills, previous experience in similar program as local contexts would be an asset
- Strong management skill, facilitation, leadership skills and accountability must be have.

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- Applicants must have a positive attitude toward problem solving and conflict resolution; ability to effectively liaise with local stakeholders.
- Applicants must have strong project cycle management skills, able to support proposal writing to Programme Manager and Project Manager.
