Construction Manager

We are in search of an enthusiastic, hard-working, and organised individual to join Doh Eain as a Construction Manager. A Construction Manager at Doh Eain should be passionate about Yangon's built heritage and its responsible preservation. This role will report directly to the Head of Design. Both Myanmar and English languages are necessary for this role.

The Construction Manager will lead the construction, restoration and maintenance projects at Doh Eain. They will then work in close collaboration with the design team in the production of an exciting new schematic design, showcasing Doh Eain's fresh, tactile approach to heritage restoration and placemaking prototyping. He will lead the construction team and be responsible for each team member.

Prior to each project, the Construction Manager will be responsible for the creation of construction schedules to ensure the best optimisation of Doh Eain resources without compromising quality.

During the construction, the Construction Manager will lead and manage the construction team and subcontractors at all construction sites, ensuring the realisation of the design intent. The role will also include being a facilitator between Doh Eain and externally contracted renovations.

The Construction Manager will be responsible for purchasing, and delegating when necessary, all materials for the construction, according to the budget approved by the design team. He or she will also assist in finding new materials, products and suppliers.

The Construction Manager will lead in the successful completion of the construction of Doh Eain's projects, including keeping track of all expenses and by working closely with the Head of Design and the Doh Eain Finance team where required.

The Construction Manager will be the focal point for the maintenance works of Doh Eain apartment and will closely monitor the process.

The Construction Manager is willing and able to reside and work outside of Yangon Region.

- Run and keep updated a Duty Roster
- Oversee the workshop inventory and Keep the Materials Inventory updated Monthly and report to Head of Design
- Oversee the maintenance of Doh Eain Heritage Homes
- Able to travel domestically and able to work short-term in location outside of Mandalay Region
