“Consultancy service for the MSD training for CREATE project team”

Purpose

The purpose of this training is to enhance the knowledge and capacity of project staff, implementing partners, and selected stakeholders on Inclusive Market Systems Development (iMSD) approaches. The training will equip participants with practical tools, techniques, and frameworks to analyze, design, and implement inclusive, climate-smart, and nutrition-sensitive market systems interventions that contribute to the sustainable economic empowerment of smallholder producers in Myanmar’s Dry Zone.

Scope of work

The training will cover the following key components:

- Introduction to Market Systems Development and the M4P approach
- Core principles and frameworks of Inclusive Market Systems Development (iMSD)
- Gender and Women’s Economic Empowerment (WEE) integration into market systems
- Nutrition-Sensitive Agriculture (NSA) and climate-smart agricultural practices
- Value chain analysis and market actor mapping
- Facilitation techniques for systemic change
- Group exercises, real-life case studies, and participatory discussions
- Action planning for field-level iMSD interventions under the CREATE project

Rationalization

Capacity building of local actors and project staff is essential to effectively implement market-based solutions that are inclusive, scalable, and sustainable. This training will directly contribute to improved project delivery and long-term impact on smallholder livelihoods and nutrition outcomes.

Qualification

The training will be led by the iMSD Specialist with support from experienced facilitators in gender, nutrition, and value chain development. Participants are expected to be project field staff, technical specialists, with a basic understanding of rural development, value chains, or agricultural extension. The training team must have experience in adult learning methodologies, participatory facilitation, and practical field applications of MSD approaches.
