Job purpose

The ICRC Economic Security Unit is looking for an Economic Security Generalist to be based in its Mandalay Office. Under the supervision of Economic Security Delegate, the **Economic Security Generalist** supports the design, implementation, and monitoring of EcoSec programs to help crisis-affected populations improve livelihoods, food security, and living conditions. Working under supervision EcoSec Delegate, the incumbent ensures alignment with ICRC's strategy, conduct field assessments, plan responses, coordinate with stakeholders, and handle reporting—requiring strong humanitarian knowledge and adaptability to evolving contexts.

Main responsibilities

- Contributes to identifying response options based on analysis of core EcoSec components like food, income, and living conditions.
- Participates in planning, implementing, and monitoring EcoSec programs, including creating action plans and conducting assessments.
- Provides regular written/oral progress reports and inputs for situation, quarterly, and weekly reports as required.
- Conducts field visits independently or with team leads to assess needs, monitor projects, and gather relevant data.
- Supports meetings with stakeholders, maintains relationships with local authorities and humanitarian actors.
- Engages in weekly and strategic planning of EcoSec activities, including meeting arrangements and field task scheduling.
- Conducts post-distribution follow-ups and gathers feedback to inform future actions.
- Maintains accurate beneficiary records and ensures proper filing of all EcoSec-related documents.

Requirements and experience

- University degree in economics, anthropology, agronomy, veterinary science, nutrition, public health or considerable experience in the humanitarian field
- Ideally 3 years overall professional experience, including 2 years' experience in a similar field of activity, preferably with a confirmed project management role in some of the above-mentioned sub-programs
- Computer proficiency, specific databases and tools (mobile data collection, programme database, etc.).
- Excellent communication skills, and fluency in written and spoken English as well as Myanmar language.
- Previous ICRC experience is a strong asset.
