The ICRC WatHab Unit is looking for a WatHab WaSH Engineer or equivalent to be based in its Yangon Office. Under the supervision of WatHab Cordinator in the framework of the Earthquake emergency response in Mandalay AoR, and the Wathab WaSH Engineer is responsible for small and non-complex projects and ensures their successful delivery within the constraints of scope, quality, time and budget. With some guidance, prepares, designs, procures, implements and commissions projects. Manages relationships with the stakeholders involved. Manages project resources and ensures project reporting.

Main responsibilities

- Participates in reviewing project briefs and supports needs assessments and surveys to identify challenges and requirements.
- Engages with stakeholders to foster collaboration and ensure alignment with project goals.
- Assists in gathering data and preparing feasibility studies, technical designs, and project proposals.
- Submits project documentation for review and contributes to project planning.
- Supports procurement processes and contract management in line with delegation rules.
- Oversees and supervises on-site implementation of works and activities by contractors or partners.
- Proactively identifies and addresses project issues, proposing and implementing corrective actions.
- Manages commissioning, handover of infrastructure, and end-user training for proper use and maintenance.
- Ensures accurate reporting and documentation using appropriate tools and prepares regular progress reports.
- Provides support to field teams, shares updates on security and progress, and assists with site visits when needed.

Requirements and experience

- Bachelor's degree in Civil Engineering, Water Resources Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Environmental Engineering, Architecture, or a related technical field.
- Professional certification or training in project management, WASH (Water, Sanitation and Hygiene), construction supervision and/or water/electrical/civil design engineering is an asset.
- Minimum 3 to 5 years of professional experience in planning, designing, and implementing infrastructure or water and sanitation projects.
- Experience working with humanitarian or development organizations, international NGOs, or in the public infrastructure sector in Mandalay is highly desirable.
- Proven experience in stakeholder coordination, including local authorities, contractors, and communities.
- Demonstrated skills in technical report writing, project documentation, and use of project management tools (e.g., MS Project, AutoCAD, BoQ preparation, GIS, etc.).
- Familiarity with ICRC's Water and Habitat approach, humanitarian principles, and results-based management is a strong asset.
- Experience working in conflict-affected or remote areas of Mandalay is considered an advantage.
