MEDICAL OFFICER (PART TIME)

LOCATION- Dawei Township, Tanintharyi

MAHAMATE @ Alliance Myanmar is the non-governmental organization (NGO) that supports community action on AIDS response through strengthening the capacity and providing technical and financial support. Alliance Myanmar in partnership with CBOs and Networks has been implementing projects, mostly on HIV preventions, testing, care & support, ART treatment and promoting the rights and reducing the stigma and discrimination against key populations including people living with HIV but also has implemented other related project activities such as Sexual and Reproductive Health and TB. To be more effective approach, Alliance Myanmar has started KPSC to support comprehensive HIV services (HIV testing to ART treatment) for key populations in 3 townships and in other townships, Alliance Myanmar has started MINI KPSC in 6 townships. MAHAMATE @ Alliance Myanmar in line with its strategic plan is expanding its scope of work to cover other relevant health issues as well. With the support of UNOPS through Access to Health Fund, Alliance Myanmar is expanding MNCH and SRHR activities in Kachin and Southern Shan State.

PURPOSE OF JOB

The part time Medical Officer Works for mini-Key Population Service Center (mini KPSC) of Alliance Myanmar, a HIV/AIDS project aiming at reducing HIV transmission and HIV/AIDS-associated morbidity and mortality amongst the high-risk and key population in Myanmar. This position is to ensure that interventions are relevant and efficient service minded, meet defined Service Delivery Standards with quality assurance, ensure the patient's safety and confidentiality and deliver the best possible health care within limited resources.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Perform HIV testing services with point of care testing for diagnosis of HIV and rapid test for syphilis using the National testing algorithm
- Record all data and results in specified forms with accuracy and responsibility
- Issue blood results for collected samples
- Using the provided national guideline for STI management, Medical Officer provides clinical consultation, diagnostic and syndromic management for STI of KPs with the

quality management and maintain confidential information of patients, their conditions and treatment provided

- Interact and coordinate with other members of mini KPSC team to meet the objectives of the program
- Ensure that the commodities are kept in standardized temperature
- Ensure that all safety guidelines are followed strictly at all times and maintain a clean and orderly environment
- Ensure infection control in the clinic, universal precautions are followed according to SOPs.
- Participate in the technical trainings conducted by Alliance and National Health Laboratory

QUALIFICATION

- Must be M.B.B.S with valid SAMA
- Must have appropriate professional competencies and qualifications on HIV testing and STI knowledge
- Able to give 4 hours per day during weekdays.
- Must have good communication skills with other team members
- Willing to work with the key populations
