GENERAL ASSIGNMENT:

Responsible for anthropometric measurements, follow up of beneficiaries in charge in the community level, Responsible to supervise the nutrition volunteers to ensure the implementation of community activities and to conduct regular awareness raising sessions on hygiene, health, nutrition and to conduct individual IYCF counselling to Caretakers.

TASKS & RESPONSIBILITIES

Objective 1: Provide nutrition technical support, develop, monitor and supervise the implementation of nutrition project activities in the field

- Assist Team Leader and Nutrition Technical Officer for capacity strengthening of implementing partners,
 Community Based Health Workers, Mother Support Group members and volunteers
- Develop action plans and regular field trips for supervision and monitoring of activities by CBHWs
- Ensure regular reporting of activity progress to the supervisor and MEAL department
- Regular travel to the field and conduct on-the-job support to implementing area

Objective 2 : Set up education sessions according to needs

- Make a list of priorities in terms of information and awareness on questions of hygiene, health and nutrition
- Adapt the methodology and supports to the relevant group in order to make them interesting
- Make sure that the education sessions strictly respect the beneficiaries and those accompanying them
- Detect any difficulties in the mother's relation with her child regarding breastfeeding/ Complementary
 Feeding
- Evaluate beneficiary's and caretakers knowledge before and after each session in terms of understanding and assimilation
- Share these information with the immediate supervisor

Objective 3: Follow-up of new admissions, absent and non-respondent children

Note the details of the patients requiring a home visit according to the criteria and pay them a visit

- Find out the reasons for their absence or non-response of the treatment and advise them to pursue the treatment
- Give advice according to the situation observed at home
- Monitor and evaluate the home visit's activity and draft a report

- Facilitate the trainings to the CHWs for the implementation of the community-level activities (MtMSGs, cooking demonstrations and nutrition sessions) as required
- Supervise and guide the CHWs for the implementation of the community-level activities (MtMSGs, cooking demonstrations and nutrition sessions).
