- Ensure regular reporting of activity progress to the supervisor and MEAL department
- Regular travel to the field and conduct on-the-job support to implementing area jointly township health department

- Together with nutrition partners, coordinate with Township Health Department for implementation of Access to Health Project (nutrition activities)
