## **Job Summary**

We are seeking a passionate and professional **Child Development Support Coordinator** to join our team. This position plays a vital role in enhancing the quality of our programs through developing the capacity of staff and children, supporting programs operation, as well as connecting resources to support the ministry. The ideal candidate will affirm our organizational mission and core values, love children—especially those from vulnerable backgrounds—and demonstrate a heart of service and dedication to holistic development.

The role also involves working closely with the international office manager and local project officers to improve program quality and strengthen capacity-building efforts.

# **Key Responsibilities**

## 1. Capacity Building for Staff

- Design and implement training programs to build the capacity of staff in providing holistic care and development for children.
- Equip staff with skills and knowledge in areas such as children's holistic development, protection, psychosocial support, trauma-informed care, photo and video taking and activity design, etc.
- Provide ongoing coaching and mentorship to staff to ensure effective implementation of training.

#### 2. Holistic Development for Children

- Plan, deliver or facilitate training programs for children to foster life skills, self-protection, psychosocial abilities, interest, leadership, career skills and holistic development.
- Develop and implement activities and workshops to help children grow emotionally, socially, and mentally. Support activities that nurture children spiritually.
- Support program related activities, including but not limited to Child Sponsorship, relief, etc. as needed.
- Monitor and evaluate the progress of children and adapt programs as needed.

## 3. Resource Networking and Collaboration

- Identify and connect with external trainers, coaches, counselors, NGO networks, and other resources to enhance the ministry and the well-being of children.
- Build partnerships with like-minded organizations and individuals to strengthen program delivery.
- Organize and facilitate collaborative initiatives with external stakeholders.

#### 4. Media and Communication Support

- Take photos and videos of projects and events to document the work of the organization.
- Translate materials or provide interpretation for various occasions as needed.
- Assist with creating reports and other communication materials for donors and stakeholders.

## 5. Donor and Visitor Support

- Support donor visits by organizing itineraries, preparing materials, and assisting with logistics.
- Serve as a liaison to ensure a meaningful experience for donors and visitors.
