She/he will work directly with Grant Managers, Education specialists to provide timely reporting against indicators and management on MEAL related purposes. She /He will work closely with KMSS Diocesan MEAL staff to support the performance and quality of the project delivery.

- Assist and support technical in program development (Baseline Assessment, Rapid Need Assessments, Logic Models Development)
- Technical support to each project team in developing MEAL plan (Logic Models, Monitoring and Evaluation Plan, Detail implementation plan, indicator tracking table, Data Quality Management Process, Feedback and Complaints Handling Mechanism, Learning and Evaluation Plan, MEAL related orientation).

Monitoring (Monitoring and Information Management)

- Based on KMSS National MEAL procedure, leads Data Quality Management Process;
 Developing standardized data collection tools, Databases, Data verification and analysis,
 Internal Routing Data Quality Assurance Plan).
- Conduct regular and joint project monitoring purposes (in-person, virtual) to KMSS Diocesan Offices.

- Lead monitoring process; designing survey methodologies including questionnaires and data collection tools and review the Monitoring Report and Take necessary actions.
- With the support of MEAL Manager, he/she works closely with Grants Managers and respective technical specialists to plan, coordinate and priorities for preparing quality data reports for both internal and external purpose.
- Contribute to total reach annual planning and reporting processes, consistent with KMSS MEAL framework and PMIS

Evaluation (Assessment and Survey)

- With the support of KMSS National MEAL Manager, participate/coordinate and cooperate with external evaluators/grant managers for the design of quantitative and qualitative participatory programme evaluations (baseline, annual and final evaluations) and project related assessments.
- Facilitate/Coordinate to external evaluator/ grant managers for the documentation of the project results, project outcome, best practices and the most significant changes.

Accountability Learning (Project Quality)

- Design/review inclusive Feedback and Complaints Handling Mechanism for varied population groups, including children.
- Provide technical support and guidance to the respective project teams from NO and Diocesan Offices ensuring that an effective system for Feedback and Complaints Handling Mechanism is established and functioning at the project implementation levels.
- Facilitate Accountability Data Analysis upon FCHM data which are submitted by Diocesan Offices and share the findings and recommendations to support strategic Programme Decision Making and Advocacy.

Capacity Building

- Facilitate training session for project staff on project monitoring, data collection by using KoBo tools, data management and analysis and any other MEAL related topics.
- Coordinate monthly MEAL meetings with MEAL staff from both NO and DOs to exchange information and lessons learned.

Coordination and representation

- Coordinate with partners to provide technical support.
- Coordinate with Program Manager, Grants Mangers, Technical specialists on all MEAL activities, MEAL budgets, proposals, reports, and data reviews.
- Provide input and assist MEAL Manager in annual reporting.
- Participate in donor and partner meetings, project kick-off and closing meetings.
