Clinical Management

- Provide and manage sexual and reproductive health related clinical and other services including counseling, health promotion and proper referral
- Ensure quality of clinical services provided by outreach clinics services according to the standards of MSI in service provision
- Take responsibility on the services provided by the outreach team
- Train and coach clinical and other team members for quality services.

Project Management

- Assist Team Leader in operations of the Clinic and Outreach Team in the township providing information, commodities and services
- Supervise sexual and reproductive health and rights awareness promotion and behavior change activities
- Supervise the clinical team and non-clinical team operating in the communities concerned
- Be responsible locally for the establishment, maintenance and ensuring proper function of the building, premises, equipment, vehicles and other materials of outreach teams and MSI programme overall as assigned by line manager/ supervisor.
- Organize, plan and implement project activities being operated in the township.

Monitoring

- Monitor project activities and achievement in accordance with donor agreement and the goal of MSI
- Monitor supply chain management of Clinic and Outreach Team including medical commodities.
- Ensure collection of data regularly according to the systems and requirements, and preparation of timely reports to Team Leader.
