Overall Responsibility

The project officer will contribute to the development and implementation of the project and be responsible for follow-up of project related activities in project sites providing efficient support to field team, facilitate the action upon receiving information in a timely and effective manner in achieving project objectives and goals.

All responsibilities should be carried out in line with relevant Marie Stopes International policies and procedures.

Project Management

- Assist Project Manager in activity planning, detailed implementation, and review to ensure quality and achievement of project outputs in accordance with project documents
- Promote information sharing in all aspects related to EMOC and ECC referrals, key information of MNCH; and provide capacity building activities for community based mobilizers to strengthen interpersonal communication skills
- Conduct visits to the referral sites; clinic and outreach to monitor emergency referral system, facilitate and provide technical support for effective communication strategies and to monitor and supervise project activity at respective townships.
- Assist in development and regular implementation of monitoring and evaluation system in order to monitor progress against outputs and indicators to assess the quality, process and impact of the project.
- Ensure timely collection, compilation and interpretation of information for timely reporting on progress

of the project.

- Assist Project Manager and project team in conducting advocacy meetings and participation in program and project review activities.
- Coordinate and provide technical assistance and planning inputs to procurement and logistics team
 for procurement and supply chain management of equipment, supplies and commodities ensuring
 MSI and relevant donor guidelines are followed and adequately documented.
