Project Summary

Providing humanitarian health assistance with outbreak and disaster preparedness and responsible in conflict-affected and disaster prone in Kayin State Project is designed to provide rapid, flexible, and responsive healthcare services in the event of communicable disease outbreaks within the targeted implementation areas. The project aims to reduce morbidity and mortality during outbreaks through timely interventions delivered by a trained mobile clinic team.

Position Summary

The Medical Doctor leads a mobile clinic team and is responsible for planning, delivering, and overseeing clinical services in project villages. This includes direct patient care, referrals, health promotion, outbreak response, and team supervision. The doctor plays a crucial role in enhancing community health during crises especially in time of conflict, disaster and disease outbreaks and ensuring high-quality service delivery in remote and vulnerable areas so as to improve population's access to essential health services and reduce excess morbidity and mortality. Two medical doctors will be hired for the project, will be based in Field and will be charged 100% from the project for 8 months.

Specific Duties and Responsibilities

Under the line management of the medical doctor, the health promotion assistant is responsible for:

Key Responsibilities:

Under the line management of the Area Manager, the Medical Doctor is responsible for:

1. Clinical Services

- Lead the day-to-day mobile clinic operations to provide essential health services to vulnerable and underserved populations especially in times of conflict, disaster and

disease outbreaks so as to improve population's access to essential health services and reduce excess morbidity and mortality.

- Conduct clinical consultations, diagnose, treat patients according to established protocols.
- Offer emergency care and referrals for complicated cases and other health conditions if necessary.

2. Health Promotion and Counseling:

- Deliver health promotion activities focusing on various topics ranging from communicable and non-communicable diseases, personal hygiene and handwashing, mental health and nutrition.
- Provide counseling services related to family planning, maternal health, and safe practices.

3. Monitoring and Reporting

- Maintain accurate records of patient consultations, treatments, and referrals.
- Prepare and submit timely reports on clinical activities and outcomes.

4. Strengthening Outbreak and Disaster Preparedness and initiate quick Response

- Strengthen outbreak and disaster preparedness and response, according to the guidelines and response plan to disasters and outbreaks under the guidance of the area manager and the program manager.
- Initiate quick response in time of conflict, disaster and disease outbreaks as a compromised medical team leader and support the Area Manager and Program Manager in coordinating emergency health responses.

5. Training and Capacity Building:

- Provide technical support and on-the-job training to mobile clinic staff, including nurses and support workers.
- Conduct refresher training sessions to ensure quality service delivery.

6. Team Supervision:

- Supervise mobile clinic team members, including nurses and clinic support staff, ensuring effective team coordination and performance.
- Support team development through mentoring and continuous professional guidance.

7. Coordination and Collaboration:

- Collaborate with the field support team for logistics and supply management.
- Coordinate with local health authorities and stakeholders for program alignment and referrals.
- Participate as a rapid response team member/leader when outbreak/disaster/conflicts occur in coordination not only with other RRT members from the organization but also with other implantation partners.
