He/she will be responsible for the effective supervision and performance monitoring of Integrated Community Malaria Volunteers (ICMVs) to ensure the delivery of quality community-based malaria services and contribute directly to malaria control and elimination targets.

- Conduct regular field visits to ICMV villages to supervise service delivery, distribute health commodities and IEC materials, collect reports, and provide technical support.
- Ensure timely and verified payment of provider service allowances and client support incentives.
- Perform remote monitoring if required to maintain communication with supervisors and ICMVs.
- Monitor stock levels, storage conditions, and consumption of health products.
- Support ICMVs in implementing health education, outreach, and malaria elimination activities according to PSI protocols.
