We are seeking a skilled and compassionate Sr. Medical Officer to join our team. This role primarily involves teleconsultation services for HIV and TB clients, providing guidance for initiating and adhering to treatment regimens. Additionally, the Medical Officer will work closely with the field team to ensure successful client referrals, especially for those in remote and hard-to-reach areas. The ideal candidate will have a strong clinical background in HIV and TB care, experience in telemedicine, and excellent communication skills.

Primary Responsibilities

- Provide teleconsultation services for HIV and TB clients, including counseling, ART initiation support, and adherence follow-up.
- Work collaboratively with the field team and technical expert to facilitate client referrals, ensuring timely initiation of ART and TB treatment in remote areas.
- Regularly monitor and ensure the effective operation of the five TB pharmacies in Yangon, maintaining adherence to treatment protocols and service standards.
- Offer clinical guidance and problem-solving support to field staff managing HIV and TB cases.

Case Management and Referral Coordination

- Provide high-quality care to patients attending the HIV/STI clinics, including STI screening, treatment, HIV testing, and counseling
- Ensuring comprehensive case management for HIV and TB clients from initial consultation to ongoing treatment adherence by working with the field team.
- Coordinate with the field team to address any barriers to successful treatment outcomes, particularly for clients in hard-to-reach locations.
- Implement strategies to re-engage clients who have been lost to follow-up, ensuring continuity of care.

Collaboration and Coordination

- Liaise with ART and TB focal points in the field and healthcare team to ensure seamless client care coordination.
- Actively participate in multidisciplinary meetings, contributing to treatment strategies and care plans for HIV and TB clients.

Supervision and Support

- Monitor and supervise teleconsultation processes, ensuring effective remote care management and support for field team members.
- Provide training and support to field team members in remote areas as needed, ensuring quality care standards are upheld.
- Provide supervision to the field team to ensure the effective facilitation of patient cases.

Data Management

- Maintain accurate and confidential patient records for teleconsultation cases, ensuring data integrity and compliance with reporting standards.
- Collect and submit monthly data reports to the HQ M&E team, contributing to ongoing monitoring and evaluation of teleconsultation impact.

Qualifications:

- Medical doctor with three years of clinical experience in HIV/TB care.
- Previous experience in HIV/TB clinic settings in remote areas with limited resources setting is preferred.
- Knowledge of antiretroviral therapy, TB, HIV/STI testing, and treatment protocols.
- Strong communication and interpersonal skills.
- Computer Literacy with Microsoft Package.
- Compassionate and nonjudgmental approach to patient care.
- Ability to work effectively in a team and collaborate with healthcare professionals.
- Commitment to maintaining patient confidentiality and upholding ethical standards.
