Minimum Qualifications

- Strong knowledge of educational challenges in rural or low-resource settings.
- Experience with a Training of Trainers (ToT) model.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Proficiency in using digital tools for training and resource development.
- Ability to collaborate with a diverse range of stakeholders, including government officials and community leaders.
- Availability for short-term travel to rural Shan State if needed.

Responsibilities

- Design and adapt curriculum resources tailored to the needs of UWS community teachers, ensuring they are practical, context-specific, and aligned with national education standards.
- Provide EOs with high-quality training materials, techniques, and mentoring to enable effective delivery of training at the school level.

Capacity Building for Education Officers (EOs)

- Conduct virtual workshops and one-on-one mentoring sessions to equip EOs with the skills needed to support teachers effectively.
- Guide EOs in implementing best practices for pedagogy, classroom management, and student engagement.
- Collaborate with EOs to identify gaps in teacher performance and develop strategies to address them.

Community Visits and Engagement

- Conduct periodic visits to schools and communities to gain first-hand insights into educational challenges and opportunities.
- Engage with teachers, students, and community leaders to ensure that training and curriculum design meets their needs.
