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### CL Organization

CL’s mission is to enhance the sustainable livelihoods and healthy lifestyles of local vulnerable people and farmers by implementing various training and projects (domestic skills, agricultural training, business start-ups, marketing training, land use training, and health care knowledge) in Myanmar.

**POSITION SUMMARY:** The Community Facilitator will play a key role in the implementation of field-level activities related to Primary Health Care (PHC), Sexual and Reproductive Health and Rights (SRHR), and Gender-Based Violence (GBV) prevention and response. The Facilitator will mobilize communities, conduct awareness-raising sessions, support mobile clinics, assist in referrals, and distribute dignity kits. The ideal candidate is a trained midwife or nurse with experience in community health and humanitarian work.

### Key Responsibilities:

- Conduct PHC and SRHR awareness-raising sessions in communities, focusing on maternal and reproductive health, adolescent health, and family planning.
- Lead or support GBV awareness-raising sessions with women, men, and youth.
- Organize and facilitate adolescent and youth-specific SRHR education sessions.
- Mobilize community members for mobile clinic visits and training activities.
- Assist midwifery-led mobile clinics in identifying and registering clients, and provide basic health education.
- Support in identifying and referring individuals for emergency medical care, including EmOC-60 and ECC-60 services.
- Facilitate and track referrals for GBV survivors and persons with disabilities (PWDs) or conflict-affected individuals, ensuring confidentiality and dignity.
- Assist in organizing and coordinating SRHR capacity-building trainings (e.g., ANC/PNC, FP, BeMOC, CMR, MISP, PAC) for community health workers and volunteers.
- Conduct follow-ups and supportive supervision after trainings to ensure learning is applied.
- Assist in the preparation and distribution of dignity kits to internally displaced persons (IDPs), women, and adolescent girls.
- Maintain proper records of distributed items and beneficiary lists, ensuring fairness and transparency.
- Support planning and execution of advocacy events such as International Women’s Day (IWD), International Youth Day (IYD), 16 Days of Activism, and International Day of Persons with Disabilities.
- Actively participate in community meetings, campaigns, and other awareness events.
- Keep accurate records of activities, participant attendance, and feedback.
- Submit regular reports to the supervisor on community needs, challenges, and activity updates.

- Report any protection or GBV-related concerns following organizational protocols.

### **Qualifications and Experience:**

- Diploma or Degree in Midwifery, Nursing, Public Health, or a related field (mandatory).
- At least 1–2 years of experience in community-based health promotion, SRHR, or GBV programs.
- Experience working with women, adolescents, and marginalized groups in humanitarian or rural settings.
- Strong facilitation, interpersonal, and communication skills.
- Basic knowledge of referral pathways, protection principles, and confidentiality practices.
- Fluency in Sagaw Karen and basic communication in English is preferred.
- Female candidates and those from the local community are strongly encouraged to apply.
- Community engagement and trust-building
- Gender sensitivity and cultural awareness
- Respect for confidentiality and safeguarding principles
- Teamwork and collaboration
- Flexibility and adaptability to field conditions
