Description of the vacant position;

Medical Action Myanmar's child sponsorship program provides education, food, household and hygiene items to over 400 children. We also work with these children as they become adults to develop their employment skills to help them become independent.

MAM mother house is a special home for orphaned or abandoned children to live safely and are provided everything they need to grow up healthy, educated and ready for an exciting future. MAM is now taking care of 13 children in mother house for their health care, education, life-skill training and vocational trainings in Hlaingtharyar. Deputy project coordinator (DPC) supports the child support program and mother house under the supervision of operation coordinator and assists in day to day operational management. DPC facilitates coordination between field team, coordination team and donor.

Key Objectives and Responsibilities in general;

Main responsibility Program implementation

- Provide technical inputs for implementation of integrated child program and mother house
- Liaise with field team and donor to track the progress against program related deliverables and update to donor
- Conduct frequent and regular monitoring visits to field sites (home visit to children and mother house)
 in Yangon
- Understand the nature of children, plan based on their needs and implement program activities as well as identify technical competencies and areas for improvement
- Support the project by conducting an assessment of children's situation and prepare a proposal and request to donor based on needs of children in terms of social support and medical care
- Conduct regular collection of information about beneficiaries, update profile of children and report to donor
- Support the necessary logistics to ensure the well-planned allocation and timely arrival of programrelated items to field sites in Yangon
- Develop new proposal in response to needs of children, prepare budget for the project, tracking and reporting documents as annual report

Monitoring and Evaluation, and reporting

- Monitor for program data entry, analyze and produce reports on time
- Collect and review, reportmonthly project reports, regularly analyze data, provide feedback and suggestions to field team.

- Regularly collect feedback and suggestion from beneficiaries and advise to improve program design or activities to meet the needs of children in targeted areas
- Ensure project reports are submitted in time.
- Work closely with the Yangon coordination team in preparing donor reports and proposal, monitoring the program progress as committed.

Training, guideline, protocol development and other tasks

- Develop protocol, guideline and deliver training for new projects related to integrated child program and mother house i
- Develop health messaging approaches/ intervention through traditional communication and social media platform
- · Facilitate good communication and coordination between different departments and donor
- Conduct any other assigned tasks by operation coordinator
