We are currently recruiting a **Physiotherapist Consultant based in Taunggyi, Southern Shan State**, directly reporting to Deputy Program Manager.

### **Job Specifics**

We are seeking a qualified and experienced candidate to design and deliver training on basic community-based rehabilitation (CBR) in Shan, Mandalay and Sagaing, aimed at strengthening the capacity of staff to support persons with disabilities in conflict-affected and earthquake-impacted areas. The physiotherapist will be responsible for developing a practical and context-appropriate training curriculum, facilitating interactive training sessions, providing relevant training materials, and conducting a monitoring and evaluation session—including pre- and post-training assessments—to measure knowledge gained and training effectiveness. In addition, he/she will carry out field visits to provide on-site monitoring and supervision support, ensuring the practical application of CBR knowledge and skills by trained staff.

This consultancy will be contracted monthly basis and initial 3 months period. The contract can be extended if necessary.

### **Specific responsibilities**

- Develop a comprehensive, practical, and context-appropriate training curriculum on basic community-based rehabilitation (CBR), tailored to the needs of the staff in Shan, Mandalay, and Sagaing.
- Design and prepare relevant training materials, handouts, and tools in appropriate languages for use during and after the training sessions.
- Facilitate interactive and participatory training sessions for the staff in the three target locations: Shan Mandalay, and Sagaing.
- Conduct pre- and post-training assessments to measure participants' knowledge gained and assess overall training effectiveness.
- Conduct on-site field visits to selected project areas to provide practical monitoring and supervision support, ensuring effective implementation of CBR knowledge and skills by trained staff.
- Provide technical support to the staff to be able to identify person with disability who need rehabilitation service and assistive devices
- To diagnose, assess and provide direct rehabilitation care to the person with disability at the community level
- Ensure systematic data collection along the project implementation, including specific donor reporting
- Prepare the training and field visit reports in a defined time frame

## **Key Deliverables**

The consultant will deliver the following:

- Comprehensive, context-appropriate CBR training curriculum developed in coordination with relevant stakeholders.
- Training materials and tools prepared in appropriate local languages, including handouts and reference guides for use during and after training sessions.
- Training reports for each completed CBR session, including pre- and post-assessment results, participant feedback, and analysis of training effectiveness.
- Field supervision reports summarizing on-site technical support provided, challenges observed, and practical application of CBR knowledge and skills by trained staff.

## **About You**

The consultant will be expected to possess the following key expertise to accomplish this assignment;

- Bachelor degree in B. Med. Tech (Physiotherapy) or other relevant subjects
- Minimum of 3 years of relevant professional experience in delivering community-based rehabilitation services related trainings
- Strong contextual understanding of Shan State and Mandalay and Sagaing regions
- Fluent in English and Myanmar, prefer to speak local language;
- Strong analytical and report writing skills
