- To edit content to maintain its original format (e.g., font and structure)
- To translate BNI members' news and interviews selected by the Duty Editor of BNI Newsroom.

- To take responsibility for some translation of publications and any news productions from the BNI Newsroom
- Need to translate 5 to 6 news per day
- To submit a monthly progress report
- Perform the translation assignments based on the needs of the BNI management team
