MAIN PURPOSE OF THE POSITION:

Contributing to the implementation of operational communication strategy in the mission according to MSF standards. Aiming at building MSF visibility, acceptance and leverage inside the country. Focusing on written content and story development, local media monitoring and management and content diffusion.

ACCOUNTABILITIES:

- The FCO will perform text editing, written and oral translation MM / ENG and ENG / MM.
- The FCO will be responsible for managing the two Myanmar social media channels Facebook and Twitter. They will work with the FCM to plan upcoming content, share it on our channels and monitor the performance of content, providing evaluative reports when necessary
- The FCO will monitor and log relevant media and social media content and produce reports on specific topics when relevant
- The FCO will visit MSF field locations in Yangon, Kachin, Shan, Sagaing, Rakhine and Tanintharyi to meet with MSF staff and patients and collect content, including testimonies, interviews and audiovisual content.
- The FCO will research and develop story ideas focusing on MSF's projects and patients, working with the communications team to find creative ways to communicate these online and in traditional media in line with mission's communications strategy and objectives.
- In the event of sustained remote working, the FCO will find innovative ways to develop content ideas without being able to visit project sites.
- Perform any other relevant tasks assigned by their supervisors as necessary. Flexibility to work afterhours as needed in the field of his/her responsibility.
