2	Introduction of the Kayin PSEA Network and network organizations	-MI shared about the previous MI-PSEA project activities and Kayin PSEA Network - the emergence after MI implemented UNICEF supported PSEA project focused on setting up complain and feedback mechanism in the selected villages. This is the 5 th PSEA Network meeting of Kayin organizations.	
3	Confirmation of the previous minutes of meeting	-A participant shared the 4 th interagency network meeting minutes and the minutes of the meeting was confirmed by the participants.	
4	Review of Kayin State PSEA Network TOR (PSEA National network inputs) Group inputs and finalizing the TOR	-MI compiled the feedback from National PSEA Network team and Kayin PSEA Network members on the ToR of Kayin PSEA Network. -A participant shared the compiled Kayin PSEA network TOR to all participants and requested the comments and suggestion from participants. Kayin PSEA-Network TOR was briefly explained to all participants in Myanmar Language.	There are some new organizations joined the Network meeting. So, MI will share again the Kayin-PSEA network TOR to all participants for their inputs to finalize it. The participants requested to upload the

			ToR for online feedback into it. Seng Aung Sein Myint, National PSEA Network Coordinator extended his support to MI team in putting the ToR online for further inputs and finalization by members.
5	Agency Mapping in Kayin State – PSEA, CP, GBV	-Organizations mapping was initiated earlier and to update it further with organizations working on PSEA, Child Protection and Gender based Violence. MI will send the template to all participants from each organization to get their inputs for Organizations Mapping.	Participants request to use online system for direct filling the inputs. A participant suggested to use Google form because if we use excel template, it is not sure to get the inputs from all. Kayin Network will follow up about it.
6	SEA Survivor Fund and its status	PSEA Coordinator (National) shared the information of SEA Survivor Fund as follows; -Background of SEA Survivor Fund (Pilot) -If small organization occur SEA case and they can't get the contact with GBV Services Providers, they can request from UNFPA, Yangon for (80,000MMK ~100,000 MMK), if require more, they can request again. If the organization connected with UN and UN partners organization will provide this amount. -If organization are not only from UN and UN partners, they can contact with GBV Services provider, they can request to mmrpsea@unfpa.org -Currently no one is using survivor fund because organizations can support themselves in current situation. -They shared the link to learn more for survivor fund (Annex 2)	-Survivor fund only for Local NGO (Not partner with INGO and UN agencies). -Survivor Fund is planning and trying to support for long term. Current only for emergency cost; shelter, NFI, Food, -Transportation charges, health. Currently Survivor fund is pilot, so we can't guess which kind of request will be in future. -If under 18 PSEA cases, we can ask or refer to Child Protection Services Providers.

activi pract exper	•	-The participants were requested to share the works and experiences related to SEA activities. Sharing by MI: -MI is implementing PSEA project in partnership with UNICEF. During 1st phase the project focused on PSEA awareness to volunteers and village leader, developing IEC materials, established Complain and Feedback Mechanism and coordination among organisations on PSEA. In the current phase of project MI is working on Consolidation of PSEA activities with support of UNICEF, MI will be developing and strengthen Survivor Support Group to support victim of SEA and link them with CFM and referral pathway and strengthen culture of protection at community level, conduct PSEA mapping (State Level) and strengthen PSEA awareness among local organisations. KMSS KMSS shared as follows; - Got the PSEA training from National PSEA Network - Conducted PSEA awareness session in CPG - 15 groups from target area and distributed awareness pamphlets in 15 villages of Hpa-an, Kawkayeik, Kyarinnseik Kyi and Thatone Shared PSEA awareness session to Child Funding Space Volunteers LWF LWF in their sharing, focused on; - Conducting PSEA awareness session to staffs - Induction to new staffs - Annual orientation included PSEA awareness - Member of GBV network - Conduct 2 times training for GBV session to Women group in project villages and they alternately shared to villages - Women group have contacts and CFM for GBV case that provided by LWF - Conduct Online GBV meeting	

-Conducted networking meetings with 29 villages 2 times per year.

UNFPA

-Conduct GBV virtual meetings, there are many members already and most of them are from CSO.

NRC

- -Conduct PSEA training to staffs and partner organizations 2 times per year
- -Using NRC community hot line sending messages (black message) weekly to beneficiaries that got from beneficiaries' contacts list for what they want to discuss, complain, consult related with PSEA.

One of UN Agencies

- -Conduct PSEA training to staffs from partner organizations and refresher training to staff of IP in Bago East.
- -Briefing session to new staffs
- -All staffs to sign CoC

SCI

- Safeguarding framework that includes PSEA and it has zero tolerance is shared in the Induction session of SCI to new staffs
- -Staffs from representative organizations need to follow it.
- -Shared the internal reporting systems; phone, email, system to be well adaptable and well trained to be assessable and visuality.
- -If getting reported case, do investigation and report the case step by step (Regional to Global) within 90 days. After investigation, action will be taken against perpetrator depending on the outcome of the investigation team.
- -Currently, SCI trying to well effort to secure the internal reporting system.
- -SCI have no practice yet to accept PSEA case from other organizations and not report as Focal to other organizations or network in current.
- -Project Focal conduct the PSEA awareness session to beneficiaries.
- -Trying to produce poster for hot line (CSG, PSEA, SH, COC) and discussion process to produce flat sheet. After confirming, will share the community.
