	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - NRC shared that they provided PSEA and child safeguarding trainings during last week for new employees and also for the staffs in partner organizations and some of the communities. - Save The Children International shared that they have provided clarifications about PSEA policy for 5 new staffs and 16 volunteers. They are also providing trainings for reporting and referral ways in this month. They are also planning to hold discussions and presentations related to PSEA including code of conduct and anti-harassment policy for other offices as well. On top of that, their plan for next month is to provide trainings for community based volunteers in Hpa-an.
